1. Enclosed is copy of letter from ENDSI dated 26 Sept. indicating that the gift of the Swiss Government to City of Genoa has been reduced and that most of the tonnage has already been lifted on the S/S Pertusola.

2. You will note that a small balance of 100 tons wheat and 150 tons fish remains at Lisbon and ENDSI requests that you arrange to load it on some ship touching at Lisbon bound for Genoa. 
