SUBJECT :- Bills of Health.

TO :- Ministry of Marine,
Directorate General of Merchant Marine.
(attn. Lt. Gen. Matteini)

1. Following discussions at the Mediterranean Shipping Board it is confirmed that countries within the Mediterranean will accept Bills of Health signed by the Port Health Authority or, where none exist, by the Senior Naval Officer of the port.

2. It is therefore requested that steps are taken to arrange the immediate re-establishment of Port Medical Officers at all Italian ports and the issue of Bills of Health for all ships sailing in the Mediterranean.

3. May this H.Q. please be informed when the Medical Officers will be re-instated, so that Medbo can be informed of the proposed date for the commencement of this port facility.
