1. With reference to your AC/630/1/TN 3 . The writer would like to point out that no staff officer for the Carabinieri has been appointed yet.
2. The subject was broached at the P.C.C. meeting this morning and the question arose whether HQ at Rome would expedite this matter.
3. While the situation is not unsatisfactory, there seems to be a small tendency amongst the Civilian Security Police to assist in cases of pilfering.
4. These will be weeded out in time but it is felt that with an appointment of a staff officer (Italian Military) who will be attached to the Capitaneria di Porto for this duty, this tendency will vanish altogether while at the same time the Carabinieri and Guardia di Finanza will not be so lax in the execution of their duties.
