1. We have been informed through our Agents in Genoa that the shortage of coal in that port for bunkering Italian ships is becoming a serious problem.

2. They advise that Capt. Koffer of the Coal Section there is willing to release coal, but he cannot do so except on the orders of the Coal Section at AFHQ.

3. A stock of 2000 tons is considered to be sufficient and it is reported to be available for such purpose: 1500 tons backpiled on the port area and 500 tons on barges.

4. As several Italian coasters are expected to call at Genoa within the next two weeks it is suggested that you take whatever action is necessary to relieve the situation.

Subject: Discharging of coal and shipment with Barges on the Po River.

In reference to our conversation of last week I am happy to inform you that my firm is perfectly equipped and ready to act as Shipping Agency at Venice, and Marghera, and to provide for the discharge of the coal from ship to barge or on land and to its freighting and shipping on the Po River to the nearest point to Milan, which according to the "Associazione Nazionale Navigazione Interna" (A.N.N.I.), which is an association of shipowners taking care of the river and coastwise traffic in the North Adriatic Sea, could be at present Borgoforte, 204 km from Venice.

I am always in contact with the A.N.N.I., and at any time I can obtain the needed tonnage to ship coal to Borgoforte or to any other place that can be reached with barges.

The A.N.N.I. is generally known, and applies the tariffs approved by the Allied Commission. I am informed that it is not yet possible to enter the Po River because of the damaged basis of Cavanella d'Adige and that for their reoperation about 20 months of work are necessary. If the higher Authorities would furnish dredges for the cleaning of the basins of Fioppa which have not been damaged, but contain much silt preventing its functioning, it would be possible in a short time to use this way. However some one should take interest in this work and, as the Director of the A.N.N.I. agrees, it would be well if the Allied Commission will intervene.

If it is not possible to reoperate the Basins then it would be necessary to go to sea by way of Chioggia to enter into the Po through the East moth, but presently it is forbidden to pass since the area is mined and 6 months are necessary to clear it. If it is requested that the shipping of the coal begin in a short time, then it will be necessary to ask the Allied Command, or through it the Concerned Authorities, to start the work of mine sweeping or better the dredging of the Fioppa Basins.

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Some bargemen have, at their own risks, managed to come out of the sea towards the mouth of the Po and it seems they have not encountered difficulties, but the prohibition remains and therefore the work requested can not be guaranteed although some of the bargemen are willing presently to run the risk -

To ship goods up the Po now it is necessary to tranship at Cavanella d'Adige or Cavarzere with a natural raising

of the cost and, in the case of coal, with some loss and the double freighting of barges from here to Cavanella or Cavarzere and from Cavanella or Adria to Borgoforte.

The transport rate by river shipping direct Venezia Borgoforte is Lit. 89 per Quintal wish full load or when river is low and a full load is not possible, i.e. one half, at last 3/4 of the carrying tonnage should be payed: if instead the quantity loaded should be 10% less then the tonnage of the barge the cost would be calculated on the load actually carried.

Having to go to sea, subordinated to the permit to navigate, a raise of 40 % of the above mentioned rates is asked. Percentage that, in the future when the risk diminishes will be reduced proportionally or will be substituted by another tariff.

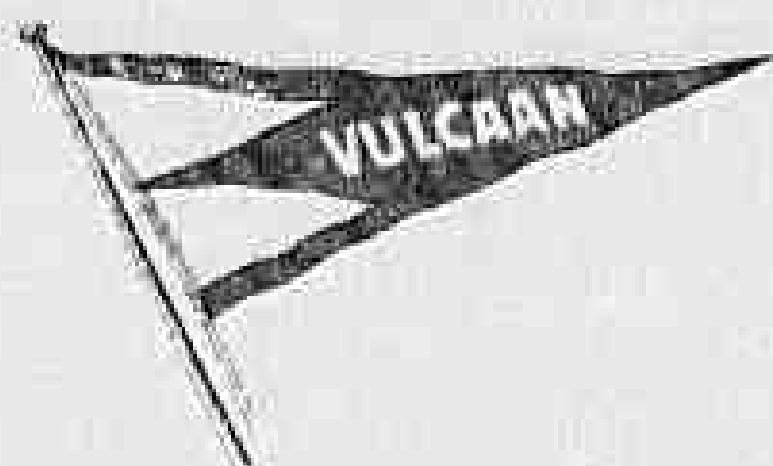

1. The Chairman apologized for the unavoidable absence of Brig. D.L. Anderson, CBE, Deputy Vice-President, Economic Section, who was attending a conference in London. He regretted that the meeting had been called so late in the month but explained that the procurement authorities in Washington and London had been late in forwarding importation programme.

2. July Allocations

It was explained that owing to late notification of importation figures it had not been possible for the Committee to meet and discuss July allocations, and recommendations submitted by the Milan Coal Committee for the North had been acted upon to save time.

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3. August Allocations

A schedule of allocations by categories of industry and by regions representing the Milan Coal Committee's views for the North was before the meeting. Pending further reports, it was agreed to transfer 5,000 tons in Lombardia and 4,000 tons in the Piemonte Regions from chemicals to general engineering, and to approve the schedule as thus amended.

4. Coke

The Chairman explained that the policy was to import coking coal instead of coke for three reasons :-

- (i) to save shipping space,
- (ii) to obtain valuable bye-products, and
- (iii) to provide employment for the Italian cokeries.

The coke would be largely utilized for the steel programme starting in September. It had been ascertained from tests that U.S. Low Volatile Coal was suitable for coking and one cargo of such coal was being set aside for this purpose in August. There was also one cargo, approximately 8,000 tons, of coke arriving during August.

5. September allocations

It was reported that a quantity of over 200,000 tons was likely to be made available for the North. There would be no increase in the usual 40,000 tons programmed for the South. The Ministry of Industry & Commerce were requested promptly to prepare recommendations for the allocations of the latter tonnage.

6. October through December

The Ministry of Industry & Commerce were requested to prepare forward estimates for the South & Centre. Any requests for reactivation of further plants would be discussed by them with Industry Sub-Commission and 1737 if approved, included in the forward estimates.

7. Electricity

It was reported that Public Utilities and Works Sub-Commission had agreed that there was no necessity, owing to the ample availability of hydro-electric power in North Italy to supply coal to Thermal Stations.

8. Gas and Domestic Coal

It was stated that the question of reactivating Gas Works in the North would be the subject of a recommendation of the Milan Coal Committee at the next meeting. In Southern & Central Italy a quantity of 18,000 tons of Gas Coal monthly was being supplied to Gas Works giving a daily ration

of approximately 5 hrs gas. The question of domestic coal for the North would also be investigated by the Milan Committee. No domestic coal apart from surplus lignite had been supplied for the South. All coal used for gas production and domestic purposes meant less for industry, with consequently increased unemployment.

9. Channels for Demands - Southern & Central Italy

The Chairman emphasized the necessity for requests for coal by private firms and others being properly channeled. It was agreed that the following procedure be adopted:-

Requests to be made to the Ministry of Industry & Commerce who will screen them and pass them on with recommendations and comments to Industry Sub-Commission. The latter in turn will pass them to Coal Division with their recommendations.

Similar demands for Northern Italy should be sent to Regional Commissioners for transmission with recommendations to the Milan Coal Committee.

10. Mr. Sachs expressed satisfaction that the coal allocations were being made on a basis of giving the fullest possible employment. He emphasized the necessity of allocating coal to industries engaged in re-construction work e.g. steel and cement.

2. General

- a. It is the intention that, as soon as possible, coal should be supplied as follows:-

(1) To AUSTRIA

From local production and overland from sources in Continental Europe.

(2) To North East ITALY

By sea imports through VENICE/TRIESTE.

It may not be immediately possible to supply the whole of the requirements of AUSTRIA from Continental Europe. Demands for coal in excess of programmed deliveries from Continental Europe will be coordinated by Headquarters, Eighth Army and submitted to this headquarters for supply from sea imports as far as may be possible. Demands for coal for North East Italy will be coordinated by Headquarters, 13 Corps.

- b. Demands should be subdivided to show civil, railway and military needs separately.

c. No coal will be dispatched to JUGOSLAVIA or to that area of VENEZIA GIULIA controlled by JUGOSLAVIA without authority from this headquarters.

3. Limitations on availabilities

Coal is in short supply throughout the world and demands will therefore be limited to essential requirements. AFHQ will advise Headquarters, Eighth Army and 13 Corps of the allocations made each month showing separately the tonnages to be imported through VENICE and TRIESTE. Railway allocations will be made on the basis of estimates from Director, Military Railway Service, civil allocations on estimates from Headquarters Allied Commission and military requirements on estimates from DST, this headquarters. Should additional emergency requirements in excess of allocation arise, this headquarters will be notified.

4. Allocations from each vessel

a. As soon as possible a representative of QM(Coal) Section, this headquarters will be dispatched to VENICE and will become responsible for coal matters in North East Italy. He will allocate the cargo of each collier arriving in VENICE or TRIESTE. He will be instructed to maintain close liaison with your headquarters to ensure that any special priorities are observed. Until this representative arrives, it is requested that Headquarters, 13 Corps make such allocations, consulting Headquarters Eighth Army where necessary.

b. It is the policy of this headquarters and of the Allied Commission to make the maximum use of civil agencies for the handling of coal. Accordingly you need only make block allocations to each main user, leaving it to those users to notify Movements at the ports concerned of the detail destinations of the coal. D.M. and Allied Commission are asked to issue any necessary further instructions on this subject.

5. Notification of Colliers

a. Since the programme will be fulfilled by the diversion of ocean-going vessels, it will not be possible to give long advance notice of the actual vessels nominated. However, you will be supplied with a copy of the full coal programme as periodically revised and also with notification by signal of vessels ordered to VENICE and/or TRIESTE.
