1. We refer to our previous application for letter dated the 8th September 1945.
 2. The daily rate of Coal Production continues to improve and this is expected to be maintained.
 3. For the months of October and November it will be appreciated if shipping space can be made available for 60,000 Tons each month proportionately spread over South Italy and Sicily Ports. Should the Ministry of War Transport report congestion at the latter ports, alternative discharging destinations would be furnished.
 4. It will be understood that this Division is anxious to transfer these stocks to the Italian mainland before loading delays resulting from seasonal bad weather commences thereby retarding shipments.
 5. We are pleased to report an improvement in communications with the Island which should avoid delays in the future in loading.

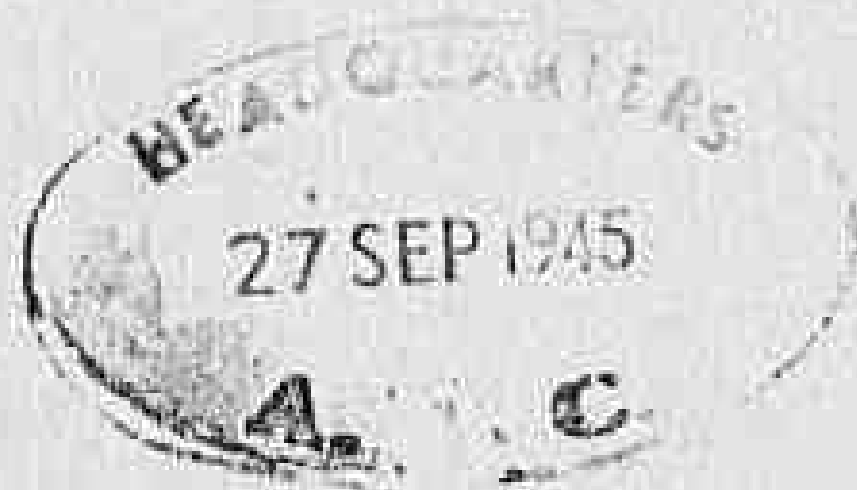

COLLIER ACCEPTANCE INCREASEDAT PORTO MARGHERA IN VENICE

Porto Marghera, coal discharge dock for Venice, can now accept two colliers drawing up to 26 feet. Previously only vessels of 24-foot drafts or less could be accepted.

Vessels may be moved from Lido anchorage at high water. Maximum draft at Lido entrance is 28 feet.

Colliers arriving in Venice with drafts greater than 26 feet may be lightened offshore at a discharge rate of approximately 100 tons per hatch per eight hour shift. In most cases, however, vessels which require lighting will be put in at Trieste.

1. The following extract from Minutes of Mediterranean Coal Reception Committee held in Genoa on 4 Sept. is passed to you for information and action as necessary. You will be advised of any further developments.

"The Committee noted a statement made to them that morning by G-4 Nav. & in that the transporter at Savona could discharge at the rate of 7500 tons per 24 hours but allowing for time lost in changing ships, maintenance of plant, etc. about only 150,000 tons per month could be reckoned upon. At Genoa rail clearance would now be provided at the rate of 1000 tons per day, although ships had been discharged in excess of this figure. Therefore a total of 240,000 tons a month through Genoa/Savona could be regarded as capable of achievement. The Committee considered that this would call for extremely fine phasing of the ships and felt that their previous conclusion should stand that 214,000 tons per month would be the maximum during the winter months."

2. Rail clearance facilities at Genoa are being studied at present with a view to a possible increase in clearance. It is, however, understood that the present programme can be accepted and cleared with existing rail facilities in both ports.

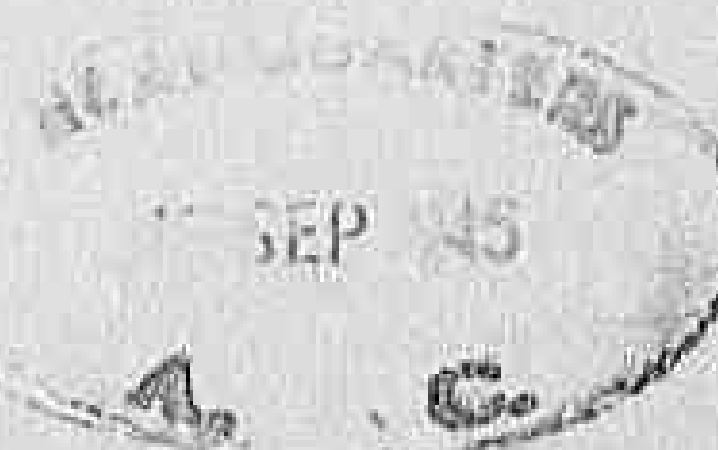

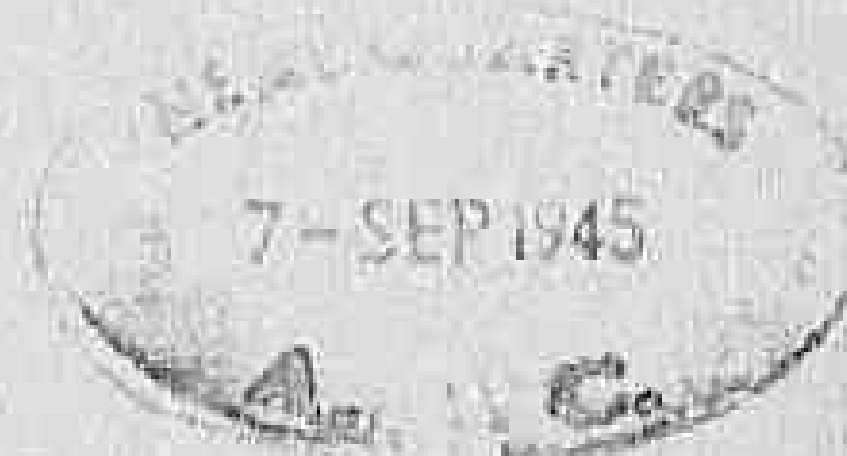

In reply to your letter BA/1586/EC, enquiries have been instituted from this Headquarters upon the subject of the suggested retention by MEDRO of the power to divert cargoes of coal, after the transfer from a military to a civilian basis.

It is understood that in the meantime authority has in fact been received from Washington for this power to be retained, and the understanding is that it will be exercised, as far as possible, in diverting vessels loaded for Italy from one port to another in Italy, and not, for example, from an Italian port to a Greek or North African port.

Our experience has been that in the past the power has been used very wisely and no difficulty, we think, need be anticipated in the future. In view of the necessity for prompt turn round of vessels, such a provision is reasonable and necessary.
