TO : AC FOOD S/C (Att. Maj. Curran)

We report copy of a signal received from Monopoli di Stato Inspector of Venice :

Motor-schooners LUIGINO, PAPAMICHELE, FILIPPO ODDO, loaded with salt, stopped at Ravenna owing their insufficient speed which does not permit them to cross in day time the mined channel. I am providing to unload them and to ship salt by rail distributing it to the near by Venezia provinces.

Should this connection still stand please entrust Rome CO.GE.NA. for getting faster motor schooners able to reach Venice.

As the question needs ~~immediate~~ resolution, we beg to inform us if this Direzione Generale must entrust directly the CO.GE.NA. or if it is better that you do it.

2. Attached is copy of letter R.XII/IND/536 dated 27 July from AMG - Venezia Region. You will learn from same that salt for industrial uses and particularly for the conservation of hides, which are rotting for lack of salt, is urgently needed in the Northern areas.
3. It is requested that 1 schooner of the capacity of about 150-200 tons be urgently allocated to the Monopolies for this purpose. The quantity to be moved from Margherita di Savoia to Venice is:

200 tons industrial salt.

4. Will you please notify this Sub-Commission of action taken in order to ensure the movement of the a/m quantity.

FILE No. : R XII/IND/536

1. Reference is made to your letter AC/5695/IND of 13 July 1945, para C., concerning salt.

2. One of the most important uses for salt is not mentioned: salting and preservation of hides for leather manufacture. At present the shortage of salt for this and all other industrial needs in this Region is critical, and it is requested that steps be taken to move salt into this Region with the greatest possible expedition. Many valuable hides are now rotting for lack of salt. The area has been carefully combed for all residual stocks.

3. It is noted from your sheets A and B that only 250 tons of salt per month are being directed to this Region for all industrial purposes. This amount is considered far less than that required for hide preservation alone.

SUBJECT: Movement of Rock Salt in Sicily

TO : Transportation Sub-Commission

1. The rock salt mines near Fermata Spina (prov. Agrigento) in Sicily have a capacity of approximately 3000 tons/month, which could be used to meet the main industrial requirements of Northern Italy.

2. However, it is understood that the bottleneck is the small storage capacity at the mines, viz. only 300 tons. This means that, should sufficient ships be made available to load the whole production at the nearby port of Porto Empedocle, at least 4 to 5 railroad wagons would be needed daily at the Fermata Spina station in order to provide a continuous movement toward the port.

3. We would greatly appreciate your investigating the possibility of improving this situation so as to enable us to plan regular shipments of rock salt from Porto Empedocle to Northern Italy.

4. This matter is of top priority as over a dozen chemical works are now idle through lack of salt.
