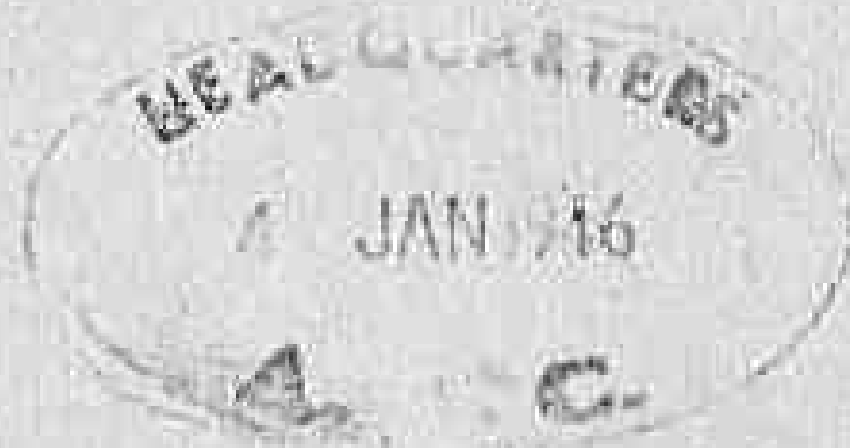

SUBJECT: Shipment of Pit Props

TO : Transportation S/C, HQ. AC.

1. Reference our Bid No. 33, dated 5 October 1945 for shipment of 2000 tons of pit props from Reggio Calabria to Sant'Antioco, Sardinia.

2. Information received from Movements Division is that no shipping will be available for the above bid in the near future.

3. While it is not within the province of Mining Division to determine shipping priorities during the current shipping shortage, we wish to point out that pit prop stocks at the Sardinian mines are now about 20,000 lineal meters, sufficient for about 7 days coal production. By strict economy this may be stretched to two weeks, but only at the risk of miner's lives and safety. If pit props are not received at Sant'Antioco before 25 November, production of coal will have to be curtailed, putting several thousand miners out of work.

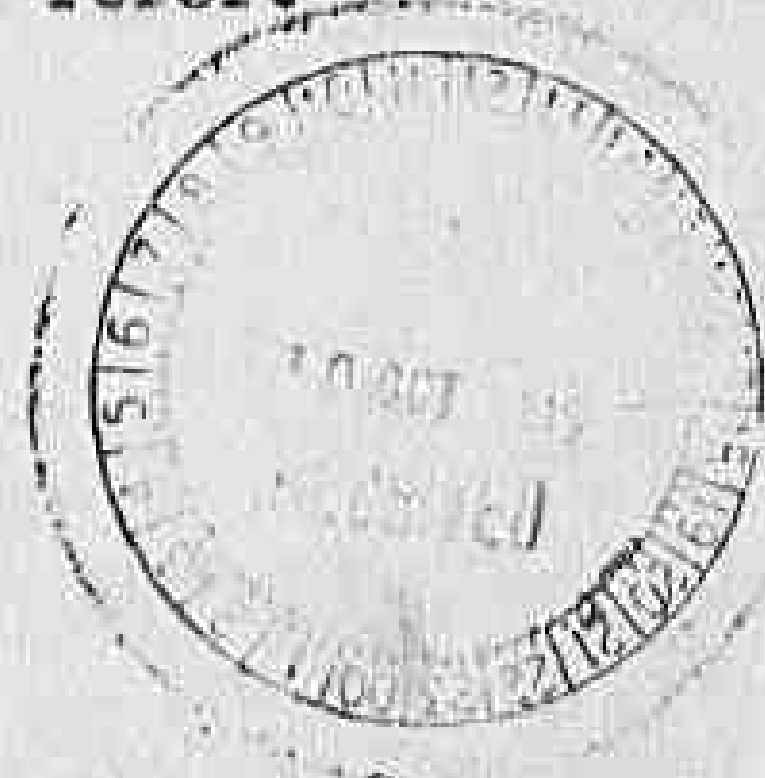

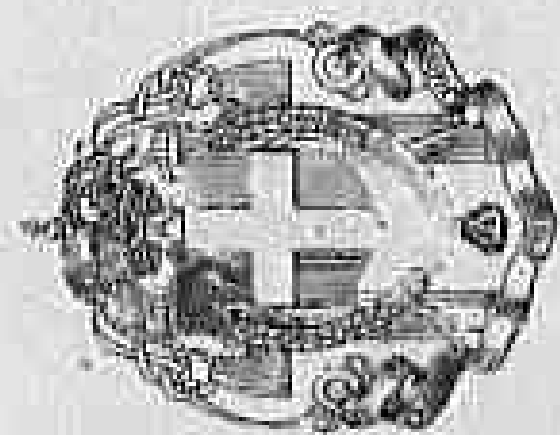

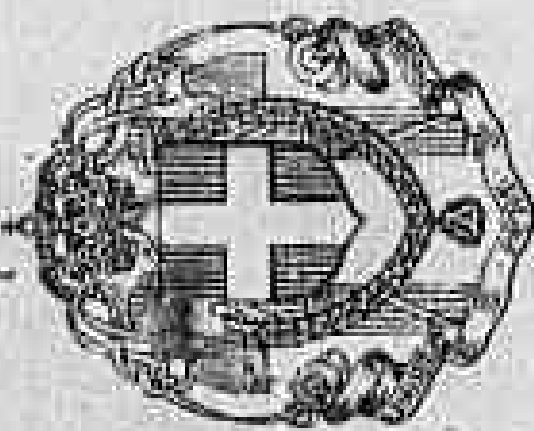

1. The serious consequences which would develop if the SARDINIAN coal mines ceased to operate due to a lack of pit props necessitate action on the part of the US Army and the British Army to assist in the production of 1000 cubic meters of pit props each for the month of July.

2. It is therefore directed that Peninsular Base Section assist in the production of an additional 1000 cubic meters of pit props in the COSENZA area during the month of July and early August. This commitment is in addition to the 3000 cubic meters being furnished at the present time.

3. The Allied Commission has been advised that Peninsular Base Section will furnish pit props in accordance with the following program and has been instructed to assume the functions which apply to ALCOM:

a. Shipments on railroads will be made within block tonnages allocated to Allied Commission in the same manner as was done during the past two months.

b. Peninsular Base Section will assist in the loading of pit props on trucks and railway cars or will perform this task completely.

c. Peninsular Base Section will assist in providing truck transportation to the nearest available railroad loading point. A flat rate charge for the 1000 cubic meters will be made to the Allied Commission for this commitment of US Army personnel and equipment. 7416

d. Peninsular Base Section will release the necessary pit props in the COSENZA area for purchase by the Allied Commission who will make its own arrangements for direct payment to the owners. Such a procedure has been followed successfully in the past in a number of cases which pertained to procurement by Allied Commission of Engineer local resources. Further, this procedure will eliminate the complicated records which were called for in the pit prop production during the last two months, as itemized in paragraph 1-f of letter, Engineer Section, MTOUSA, dated 30 March 1945, Subject: Production of Pit Props, to the Engineer, Peninsular Base Section.

e. By following the above program, in particular the part which Allied Commission must fulfill in the financial arrangements, it will not be necessary for the military to become involved in complicated book-keeping and accounting procedures.

f. Consignments will be made by the Allied Commission representative in the COSENZA area to the desired points of destination. This will in particular relieve the military of making up shipping tickets, since the Allied Commission will be both the shipper and the consignee.

4. ALCOM has been advised that the delivery of pit props to the final destination, SARDINIA, during the month of July could not be guaranteed due to the lateness of the request and the lateness of making necessary arrangements for transportation. ALCOM was requested to make all arrangements for rail and water transportation. Further, ALCOM was instructed to make firm plans for pit prop production by the A.C./Italian Government beginning with month of August.
