1. Reference recent telephone conversation (Major Laraman-- Major Haydon) regarding the requested part-discharge of S/S Lawrence Brangles at Reggio Calabria.

2. It is confirmed that originally the Ministry of Food, on advice received from its representative in Sicily, requested that the next grain ship be discharged entirely at Messina. Subsequently, at a conference of all Southern Italy's Food Controllers held in Rome on 31 August 45, it was ascertained that Sicily was far better stocked, as compared with other parts of Southern Italy, than its Italian Food Controller had led the Ministry of Food to believe, and an immediate need of grain on the mainland became apparent.

3. In these circumstances, the Ministry of Food again contacted this office and requested, if possible, the complete diversion of the above-mentioned ship to Reggio Calabria, or failing that, at least a half-discharge at the mainland port. As this S/C is still responsible for ensuring as far as possible the equitable allocation of imports of grain to the various parts of Italy, it had no alternative but to pass this request on to you for forwarding to W.B.A. with a strong recommendation that it be granted.

4. It is well understood here that such a change as this involves a considerable amount of additional work; and therefore every effort is made to avoid presenting such a request. However, you will doubtless appreciate that the food control organization of the Italian Government is not as efficient as it might be. 2. It is confirmed that originally the Ministry of Food, on advice received from its representative in Sicily, requested that the next grain ship be discharged entirely at Messina. Subsequently, at a conference of all Southern Italy's Food Controllers held in Rome on 31 August 45, it was ascertained that Sicily was far better stocked, as compared with other parts of Southern Italy, than its Italian Food Controller had led the Ministry of Food to believe, and an immediate need of grain on the mainland became apparent.

3. In these circumstances, the Ministry of Food again contacted this office and requested, if possible, the complete diversion of the above-mentioned ship to Reggio Calabria, or failing that, at least a half-discharge at the mainland port. As this S/O is still responsible for ensuring as far as possible the equitable allocation of imports of grain to the various parts of Italy, it had no alternative but to pass this request on to you for forwarding to W.S.A. with a strong recommendation that it be granted.

4. It is well understood here that such a change as this involves a considerable amount of additional work; and therefore every effort is made to avoid presenting such a request. However, you will doubtless appreciate that the food control organization of the Italian Government is not as efficient as it might be. There is, moreover, noticeable desire on the part of all the regional representatives to try, by presenting their respective stock positions in as bad a light as possible, to safeguard their own regions, irrespective of the over-all supply situation. It is this attitude which makes it all the more difficult for this Sub-Commission, as regards Southern Italy, to give a firm request for diversification on reliable information.

Foreseeing a future import of cereal from Foreign Country, this Federazione calls the attention of this Sub-Commission to the unloading of half cargo of cereal in Messina and half in the Port of Milazzo.

In anticipation of the bad season, we already have notified you that the port of Messina has no warehouse accommodation and the cereal must be stockpiled in Port, waiting to be transhipped.

If the ship can be unloaded in the Port of Milazzo, the commodity can be immediately warehoused.

Inclosed in the letter of the 13 July, a report of the Port Commandant, Milazzo, explained that the ship could easily be unloaded in Milazzo as second port discharge.

The Italian Government could, by this way, save the heavy expenses of transport from Messina to Milazzo. 7763

Report has been received from Ministry of Agriculture and Forests pointing out that the estimated Sardinian wheat production of this years crop will only be about 800,000 quintals, which is barely sufficient to meet the legal retentions. As a result, the non-farm population will be dependent upon grain imported from abroad or from the Italian mainland.

2. The Ministry notes that if importations are made ^{into Cagliari,} the wheat must move the following distances:

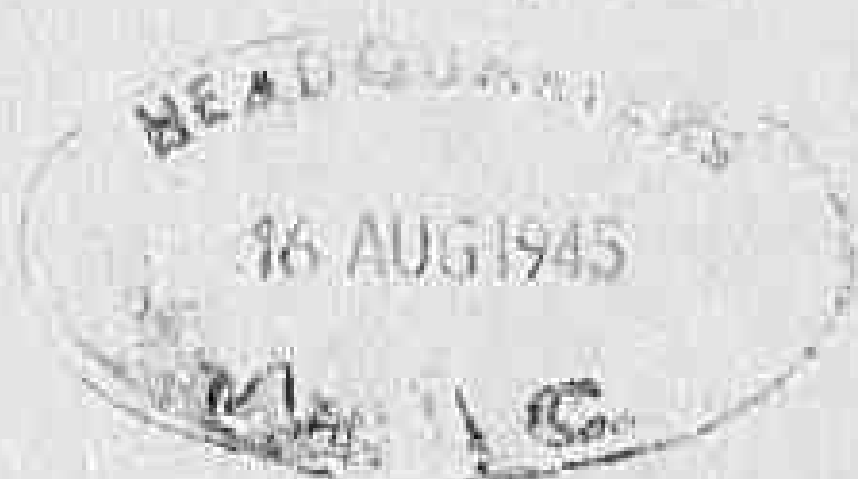

The Federazione Italiana dei Consorzi Agrari with their letter of the 13 of July sent for info to us, asks the Allied Commission to obtain that the vessel with cereals from abroad routed to Messina should discharge only half their cargo at this port, and the rest to be discharged at the port of Milazzo. This decision is taken in consideration of the fact that the industry is split 50% in Messina and 50% in Milazzo.

The Federazione has also pointed out that the Consorzio of Messina though in charge of the delivery of the goods for Milazzo, being unable to obtain the wagons needed to rail them, is forced to leave the cereals on the quay for various days which is causing much damage, also because not withstanding the efficient system of guarding the goods it is possible that a considerable amount of pilferage may take place.

In view of the fact that such losses are very bad for the economy of the country and also the high expenditure for transport (about 200 lire per Qle) does not help in that respect, we are asking the Allied Commission to examine this request of the Federazione Consorzi Agrari.
