With reference to our note No 2292 dated 6 Dec, regard the cargo of wheat for the Holy Father shipped from Montreal on the S/S Highland Park, we have been informed that the ship will arrive to Italy towards the end of December and that before reaching Castellammare di Stabia will first dock at Genoa and Naples.

This would facilitate the possibility, already suggested by us; that the ship dock, in the way of an exception, at the Port of Civitavecchia which would facilitate the allocation and employment of the railway cars needed for the movement to the Vatican.

We permit ourselves to recommend to you to consider our suggestion and thank you for what you may dispose in regard.

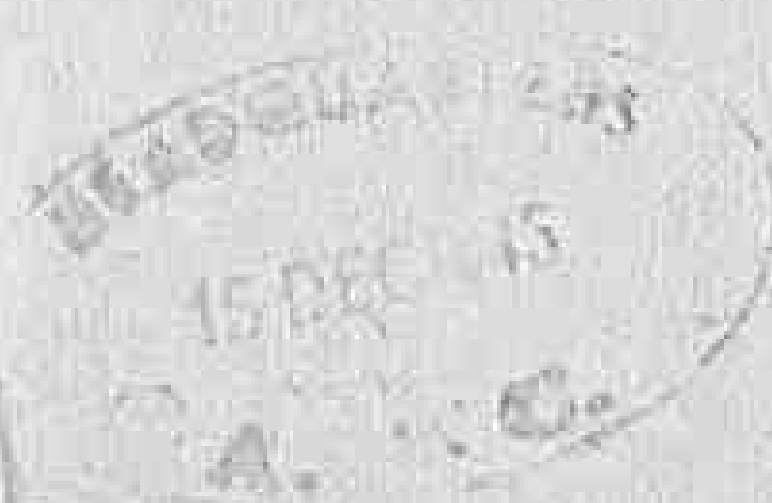

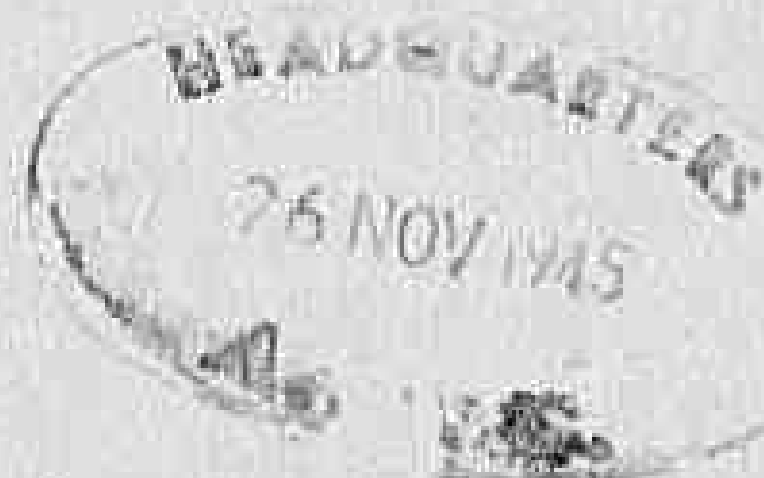

1. Reference Washington's RLT 717 of 16 Nov. made to USA Naples.

2. It is understood this signal indicates that the November grain programme will total 170,000 tons. It also states that it is proposed to load 43 ships in December with a lift of 369,000 tons. These cargoes will be bulk ones and in addition several cargoes will be loaded in the River Plate.

3. The possibility of these cargoes being cleared through Italian ports is now being gone into.

4. It is requested that you give immediate consideration to the provision of bays in all ports likely to receive cargoes of bulk grain, and to the question of warehouse accommodation. Numerous coal ships are planned for December and succeeding months and Rail Clearance will be taxed by simultaneous arrivals of large tonnages of coal and grain.

1. Information has been received from Washington that it is proposed to load 43 ships in USA ports in December with bulk grain. This will mean a total of 365,000 tons of bulk grain. In addition it is expected several wheat cargoes will be loaded in the River Plate, assuming loading commences during the first days of the month, vessels should arrive in Italian ports from the latter part of December onwards.

2. The choice of ports and the possibility of accepting this grain programme in full is now being considered. Owing, however, to the heavy tonnages of coal for the same month (700,000 tons is planned) clearance by rail is bound to present a problem.

3. It is certain that bids made for port tonnage allocations for December and January, which have already been submitted to Import Programming & Port Reception Committee, will have to be amended in view of the information just received.
