SUBJECT: Transportation of Empty Olive Oil Drums Ancona to Bari

TO : Hq. AC Transportation Sub-Commission

1. Because the accumulation of empty olive oil drums at Ancona can not be estimated beforehand, and because failure to return empty drums as they become available retards the movement of olive oil, the usual bidding procedure is not satisfactory for the return by sea of empty drums Ancona to Bari.

2. Is it not possible to secure permission for the Consorzio Agrario di Ancona to backload empty drums on ships going from Ancona to Bari without filing the usual bids? The permission could be made contingent upon shipping space being available beyond that required to move regularly bid cargo.

3. Your advice concerning the above will be appreciated.

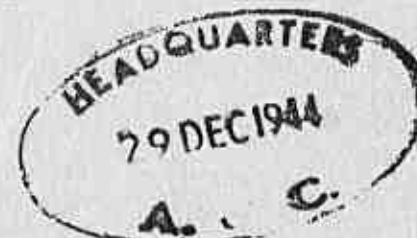
