1. Please refer to our letter 51-7/58/Food dated 5th November listing agrumi available for shipment 15th - 20th Nov.

2. As you requested we have had the proposed shipping program revised to supply Piemonte and Lombardia through Venice rather than through Genova. Below is the revised availabilities which replace those shown in our letter referred to above. The 500 tons shown below for Genova will be for distribution in Liguria Region and the 3000 tons shown for Venice will be for distribution throughout Lombardia, Piemonte and Venezia Regions.

3. Because of the difficulties of securing rail transportation from Sicily caused by the lack of coal, we will appreciate your efforts to secure shipping for at least a part of the agrumi as soon as possible.

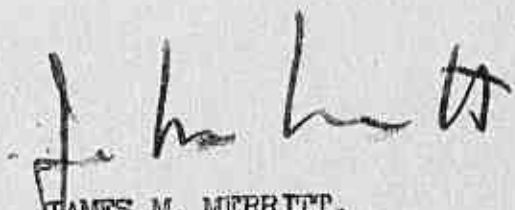

In the meantime enquiries are being made from shipping authorities to ascertain if a suitable tanker can be allocated to lift the tonnage mentioned.

SUBJECT : Movement of Coal Tar.TO : Transportation Sub-Commission.
(Attention: Capt. ~~White~~)

FROM : Industry Sub-Commission.

1. The firm of SAICA, who own a Coal Tar Distillery at Leghorn, now in full working condition, have requested that 1,200 tons of Coal Tar, low temperature type, be moved by sea from Sant'Antioco (Sardinia) to Leghorn.

2. This would allow them to resume the production of valuable items now in short supply in this country, such as Distilled Coal Tar and Pitches for Road repairs (720 tons), various Solvent Oils for paints, varnishes, inks, rubber etc. (100 tons), Carbolic Oils for disinfectants, synthetic resins etc. (75 tons).

3. In view of the importance of such a production for the Italian Chemical Industry, we would greatly appreciate your investigating the possibilities of obtaining a tanker to be used for this purpose.

4. The whole trip, including loading and unloading, would probably last less than a week.

5. Consignor would be the Azienda Carboni Italiani (A.Ca.I.) at the port of Sant'Antioco (Sardinia), and consignee the firm S.A.I.C.A., Via Marzocco 7, Leghorn.
