Expected shortly to be barged from PALERMO to VE NICE is miscellaneous assortment of equipment to be used in fitting up liner VULCANIA to transport approximately 4500 troops from ITALY to UNITED STATES on initial voyage. As there is included highly critical cargo, request ABC assign a security officer to VULCANIA to receive cargo deliver to Italian engineers aboard vessel engaged in installation of bunks, electric light fixtures, temporary fire protection, ETC. Cooperation of WEA is requested in arranging with ship owners in providing the necessary workmen from the shipyard at TRIESTE that as much of this troops installation may be completed before the vessel is ready to be moved to TRIESTE, as it is not intended to delay vessel for troop fitting beyond the time required to render fit for the voyage to UNITED STATES. Adriatic Base Command will provide trucks to transport workmen from TRIESTE to VENICE where they should live aboard ship. Wages of workmen and food will be provided by COGEMA for US ARMY account, in connection with which WEA ROME is asked to consult and ask the cooperation of General MATTEINI. The master of vessel should be requested to place in strategic positions about ship the 24 handybilly portable fire pumps included in the shipment that adequate fire protection is at all times provided through this equipment and proper fire drill. Troop bunks are to be made from pipe and chain, with canvas bottoms, instead of timber, included in shipment, for which purpose electric welding outfits are also included. PENNSA is requested to lend 2 enlisted men for a few days

to insure Italian workmen are properly instructed in electri welding pipe and chain
bunks. Upon completion of installation of troop equipment, tools are to be turned into
PENBASE upon arrival of vessel at NAPLES.

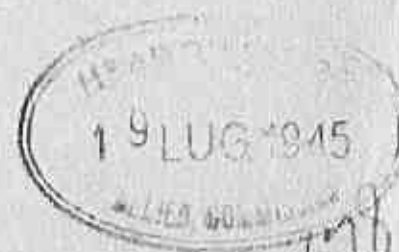

Permission for the transportation of 1 motor D.W.
of C.A. 360 and supplies.

We pray you to obtain the authorization from the
Military Allied Commission to transport on our own behalf
on the SS Santa Chiara from Genoa to Naples (Castellammare
di Stabia) the below listed material which belongs to us :

- No. 1 Motor D.W.6/Lu/423/of CA 360
- " 1 thrust bearing axle
- " 1 bronze propellor for the above axle
- 2 Compressed air bottles for starting of motor
- 3 Wooden cases with material and tools
- 3 Raw plate box container for diesel oil
- 1 Raw plate box container for lubricant oil
- 2 Motor winches of CA 9

The total weight of the material is 23 tons.
We declare that the loading and unloading will be done
with our means without interfering with the normal work
of the ship and the material will be put on the deck so that
we will not occupy any space in the hold which may be used
by the Allied Authorities.

Our agent Mr. Silvio Bonaso with office at Via
Porto Reale 1/40 will take care of the loading in Genoa
while our office will accomplish all the other operations at
the arrival of the merchandise in Naples.

We are waiting to know if this application has
been accepted by you, in order to inform our agent in
Genoa and the Captain of the Santa Chiara.
