1. As requested, we are submitting hereunder the Shipping program for raw materials for the Italian Chemical Industry for November 1945.

2. Phosphate Rock ex French North Africa.

It is understood that shipments are likely to be resumed before the end of October. The following is our tentative schedule based on our September program (Schedule "A" dated 30/7/45) for November including such loadings as may be made in October. Please note that the highest priority should be given to Southern Italy and the Islands, in order to prevent their factories from closing down.

SUBJECT: Pit Props Shipment

TO : Transportation S/C, HQ. AC.

1. Enclosed are three bids for movement of pit props from Reggio Calabria and Crotone to Sant'Antioco, Sardinia.

2. The matter is urgent, as production of Sardinian coal is dependent on pit props. In addition the ports must be kept as clear as possible for a stockpile of timber to be produced during October and November for winter mining operations.

3. Shipments from Crotone will end with the October commitment.

4. It is expected that shipments from Reggio Calabria will continue at the minimum rate of approximately 1500 tons per month.

5. Please note that an investigation into the cause of the short loading of the "Gaeta" on 8 September, made by a Mining Division officer discloses that:

a. Over 1000 tons of pit props were on hand at Reggio Calabria on 10 September ready to be loaded when the "Gaeta" left port.

b. Reason the props were not loaded was that the "Gaeta" was unsuitable for carrying props, and could not load to capacity because the port is not equipped to handle a ship of 8000 tons.

- g. This officer further states that ships larger than 2000 tons displacement should not be sent to Reggio. Preferable size is 1000 - 2000 tons. Schooners of 300 to 600 tons are too small and cannot handle the loading efficiently.

We have recently been put under considerable pressure by individuals desiring to move salt into the North by road because of the shortage of salt in that area. We have refused their request on the ground that although there had been a shortage we had done very well in securing shipping due to load in October. However, we wish to avoid a reduction in loadings in November which would recreate the salt shortage and put A.C. in an embarrassing position because of the strong position we have taken against the movement of salt into the North by road.

3. We will appreciate your efforts to see that ships are assigned to load 8000 tons of salt for Genova in November.

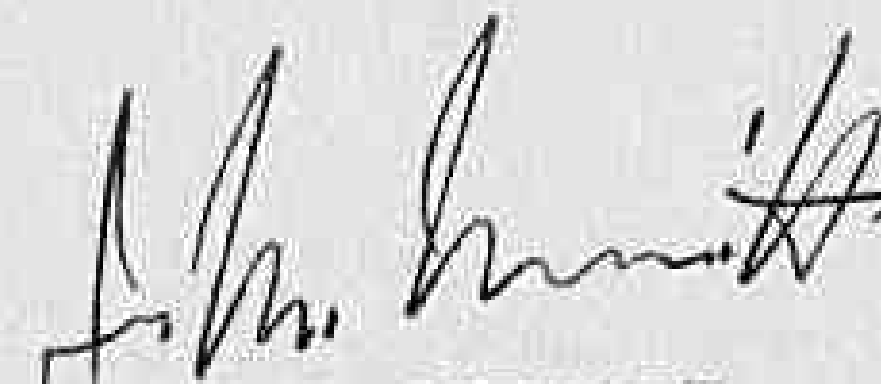
