Ref your letter AC/301/C/Tn 4 dated 3 Nov; the wagon in question was reported to Movement NAPLES by ISR on 13 Nov 45, when instructions were given to move the wagon to PONTECAGNANO.

On examination contents of the wagon was found to be batteries. This commodity is dealt with by a Depot at CASALNUOVO and the wagon was reconsigned there for immediate off loading.

It is apparent the ISR instead of reporting such instances locally are taking the matter up with their HQ consequently the wagon remains on hand until such time as the information filters through to this HQ. It would thus save an unnecessary amount of correspondence and wagon standage if the ISR would deal with such instances locally. Please instruct them accordingly.
