SUBJECT : Wheat Movements.

(attention Ing. Biondi)

Reference is to your letter M 312/18819/2.25.46, dated October 4, 1945.

1. Instructions have been issued to all RTO's that they will not interfere with the allocation of cars, except in emergency, and that in such cases they must report the circumstances to this HQ. It is suggested that all ISR officials concerned should be told of this arrangement and that they be instructed to advise you immediately any difficulty arises.

2. The case mentioned in your letter occurred a month ago and any protest which may be justified is so belated as to have little value. Also, the full circumstances are not given - it is not stated whether sufficient box cars for the Mule loadings were demanded, and if so, whether sufficient were actually placed.

If the RTO took more Box Cars for Mules Loading than he had ordered, and thus prevented the movement of wheat, it would be a clear case for immediate complaint.

3. It is expected that the instructions which have been issued will do much to prevent similar complaints arising. It is important, however, that any disregard of these instructions shall be made known to you immediately.

SUBJECT : Wagon Supply Piombino

TO : ISR

(attention Ing. Biondi)

1. Your letter M 312.18190.2 M.A. 14.01 dated Sept. 15th is noted.
2. During a scarcity of wagons, long shunting operations are essential in order to collect empties and meet demands. The high priority of Port Clearance should have resulted in a special effort to collect and supply Piombino with empties. There is no evidence that such an effort was made and it is considered that too much reliance was placed on a supply of High Cons arriving for Piombino from Rome.
3. The ultimate result of this failure was that a steamer was delayed for three days, also that a large quantity of coal was stacked on the quay, and had to be double-handled. This disability cannot be compared with the shunting and haulage which may have been necessary to prevent it.

1. The 55 high sides empty cars grouped at Piombino in order to assure unloading of coal ship on Sept.9 and following days, have been forwarded to the Port of Leghorn by order of the commanding officer of that Port: Capt. MAIR.

2. It has not been possible to replace above cars because the empty ones of same type were either engaged with other Allied transports, or so far away from Piombino and divided in such a way that no advantage was possible by their forwarding, which should have required long shunting operations and a lot of time. Only a damage was to be expected by such an operation because for a few days we couldn't have utilized those cars neither in Piombino nor in the stations where they were.

3. On account of lack of cars, it has neither been possible to furnish the empty ones to the Firm CIDONIO, Contractor for the through line works.

- 1)- I 55 carri vuoti alle sponde accantonati a Piombino per garantire la discarica del piroscampo carbone nei giorni 9 e successivi, vennero inviati al Porto di Livorno d'ordine del Sovrintendente di quel Porto, Capitano MAIR.
- 2)- Non è stato possibile provvedere a sostituire i predetti carri, perchè i vuoti della specie o erano già impegnati per altri trasporti conto Allesti, oppure erano tanto lontani da Piombino e così frazionati nelle varie stazioni che nessun vantaggio sarebbe derivato dal loro dislocamento, che avrebbe richiesto lunghe manovre ad un tempo non breve. Le sarebbe anzi derivato danno, perchè per alcuni giorni non sarebbero stati utilizzati nè a Piombino, nè dalle stazioni in cui si trovavano.
- 3)- Data la mancanza di carri non è stato possibile neanche fornire i vuoti occorrenti alla Ditta CIDONIO, che esegue i lavori della direttissima.

SUBJECT : Wagon Supply Pionbino.
TO : ISR General Direction
attention: Ing. Bertoli

1. Advice has been received that 55 High Cons which had been placed for loading coal ex Strip at Pionbino on September 10th were removed empty to Leghorn on that date.
2. It is explained that the wagons were used to convey prisoners of war from Leghorn on September 10th.
3. At 1700 hours on September 9th there were 211 empty High Cons in the Florence Compartment and at 1700 on September 10th there were 301.
4. Up to noon September 11th Pionbino is still without wagons and apparently nothing is being done by Florence Compartimento to supply.
5. While it is deplorable that the Florence Compartimento should make the mistake of ordering the cars away there is absolutely no excuse for neglect to replace them.
6. As a result of this incompetence a steamer has stood idle for 2 days with 8000 tons of coal and the seriousness of this delay cannot be too strongly emphasized and it is therefore suggested that the matter be given full investigation.

I. Reference your letter Tn. Fl. N.50, Subject Wagon Delay,
I ordered to issue the following Routine-Orders to be dispatched to all our Stations:

" Allied Command complains about serious delays in unloading wagons in all Compartimenti and has estimated that 600 wagons are out of service because of delays of over 48 hours in unloading.

Not-with-standing my repeated recommendations, the unloading of wagons does not proceed satisfactorily, so that on the 14th August there were in:

Cecina 19 cars standing over 3 days
Empoli 25 cars average unload 6 per day
Castel-Fiorentino 7 cars average unload 1 Per Day.

I dispose, that, from now on, the Stations show me each day a written Report about all the wagons which remain over 48 hours unloading, declaring the causes and informing which precautions have been adopted: The organization service to have the Firms informed about the arrival of cars, should be done with great attention and very carefully.

The IRS Direction in Florence Compartimento, remarks that most private Firms do not handle unloading of rail ~~cars~~ cars consigned to them, as quickly as they should.

Owing to shortness of cars the delay in unloading them, greatly affects the question of transportation.

All concerned are therefore asked to consider the difficulty of present situation and to keep in mind that ISR. may be obliged to refuse spotting of wagons to those Firms that will have proved unable to handle unloading of their cars within 48 hrs. of arrival of the same.
