1. It is understood that application has been received by this Sub-Commission's Registrar in Milan from the Transportation Officer RD-Bergen for the introduction of a passenger service between Graveline-Bergen-Leslie.

SUBJET : Lt. Col. H. Civilian passenger train facilitated
in the North.

1. Director, Military Railways Service, has informed our Military
Services' personnel in ~~North~~ ^{not} that additional civilian
passenger train services will ^{not} be introduced in the North without prior
consent of his Headquarters in Rome.

2. This step is necessary to ensure careful watch on fuel con-
sumption, use of civilian stock, and to ensure centralization of demands.

3. Any application for additional civilian manpower services
should be made by local ~~High~~ ^{not} Commandant, through channels to Lt. Col.
Headquarters, Rome, who will submit to the Transportation Comptroller
for action with Military Railways Service.

4. Purify local convoys on electrified lines, where no additional
stock is required, and be acquainted with local military railway service
representatives, but transportation consequences at this time
must be kept advised of any alterations to existing services.
