1. Reference is to your letter AC/5616/IND of 25 August 1945.
2. The tonnages outlined in your letter are considerable, but there is a difference between those submitted by your Sub-Commission and those given by the Food Sub-Commission, in respect of the movement of salt.

1. Refer your letter AC/100/227/Tn 1 of 20 August.

2. Salt production at Volterra amounts to 700-1000 tons per month. A portion of the above production is shipped to Siena and Arezzo which would not be reasonable rail moves even though rail line 227 were open. The repair of line 227 will merely facilitate movement of salt to Florence and Grosseto which amounts to perhaps 500-600 tons per month.

1. The Italian State Railways have asked for authority for the rehabilitation of Line 227 between Cecina and Volterra. The distance involved is approximately 58 kilometers and there are 15 bridges to be reconstructed and several kilometers of track to be replaced and other works of minor importance to be completed before the line can be restored to service. It is estimated the cost will be about 300,000 dollars to put the line in operable condition.

2. The Italian State Railways indicate the main reason for opening the line to be to provide service for the salt mines located on this line. Will you please advise the extent of traffic which would be forthcoming, should the reconstruction of the line be undertaken.

Rehabilitation of the line, Cecina-Volterra is being warmly solicited in order to connect the Volterra salt-pits with the Rome-Pisa line. We therefore submit to your approval such rehabilitation and inform you about what follows:

1. 13 bridges are to be reconstructed (? iron made and eleven masonry made and arch-shaped others, four of those with more than one span).

A few kilometres of track and some other less important works have also to be restored.

2. About lire 30,000,000 is the estimated expense.

3. The needed materials are:

- 1) Cement - 1600 tons.
- 2) Petrol - 3000 litres (2000 litres monthly in 6 months).
- 3) Oil 400 Kc.

Letter from this Headquarters dated 26 June 45, subject as above, is cancelled and the following substituted:

1. Effective 1300 hours, 1 July 1945, Italian State Railways will assume responsibility for operation of Leghorn Yard and Line 428, Leghorn to Bocca d'Arno. Selected personnel of the 719th Railway Operating Battalion will stand by in Leghorn Yard and on Line 428 for a few days to supervise and assist ISR with the operation in Leghorn and on Line 428. All other personnel of the 719th Railway Operating Battalion will be withdrawn as of 1 July.

2. Supplementary to letter from this Headquarters 18 June 45, effective 1 July 1945, 774th Railway Grand Division, MRS Headquarters, Rome, will have jurisdiction over the following rail lines in the Florence and Bologna Compartimenti through traffic offices located as follows:
