1) With your letter No. 40/Mat 5/27 dated 19th inst. you have informed us that you cannot supply further carbide to be used for the cutting of joists on the lines Rieti-Terzi-Orte-Chiusi, and you ask us to use high pressure gas with cylinders supplied either by the Administration of Italian State Railways or by the contractor Zerbini.

For said works the contractor Zerbini has collected only 1000 Mos of carbide from the 4000 Mos required and allotted. There is a balance of 3000 Mos. which can be delivered 1000 Mos per month.

b) Line Rome-Chiusi: The Firm has to complete at Orte the cutting of the joist on the Tevere river, interesting the line Orte-Terzi, and has to provide at Bassano for the cutting of a section of the demolished joist.

For said works the firm has collected only 1000 Nos of carbide from the required 2500. Therefore there is a balance of 1500 Nos to be delivered within two months.

c) Line Civitavecchia-Orsago: The Firm has to complete the cutting of the joists on the Mignone and Marta rivers. 4000 Nos of carbide are required (about 1000 Nos per month).

SUBJECT : Calcium Carbide for Florence-Empoli-Pisa Line.

1. The Chief of Works Section ISR has requested the Transport. Sub-Comm. to furnish 17 tons of calcium carbide, over a period of three months for the rehabilitation of the Florence-Empoli-Pisa Line.
2. In order to rehabilitate one track, about 80 km and 28 km of side tracks must be relaid. Each rail has been broken in the middle by German mines. It is intended to square up the ends of the broken ended rails and burn bolt holes for placing angle bars.
3. The ISR Engineers have estimated that this will require approximately 17 tons of carbide.
4. Will you please furnish a release for 5 tons, from a Depot either at Pisa or Florence, with which to start this urgent work.

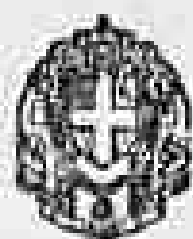

It is necessary to repair the tubes and fire boxes and, all the Railroads are completely out of stock.

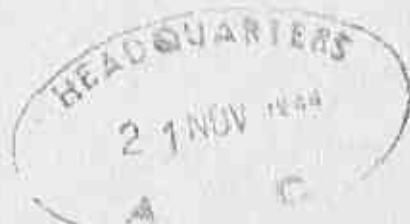
