Strade Ferrate Sarde which was made the 14 of the current month.

No. 17 Railway steel tires located in rooms in the central area of Leghorn now occupied by German P.W.

No. 2 Locomotive furnaces in via Ufficio dei Grani 2 now occupied by the American Depot 12 L 55.

The above mentioned material could not be taken away before because of the war, but since it is of the utmost necessity for the continuation of the work of the railroad, they must be taken out so that they can be sent to Sardinia via Civitavecchia.

The Allied Provincial Administration (A.M.G.) of Livorno finding the material in the Areas occupied by the Allied Government has asked permission to the A.C. Transportation S/C in Rome and will consequently authorize the taking away of it.

We pray the Ministry to explain our case to the A.C. in Rome so that it may release the permit to take away the material in Leghorn and send it to Civitavecchia.

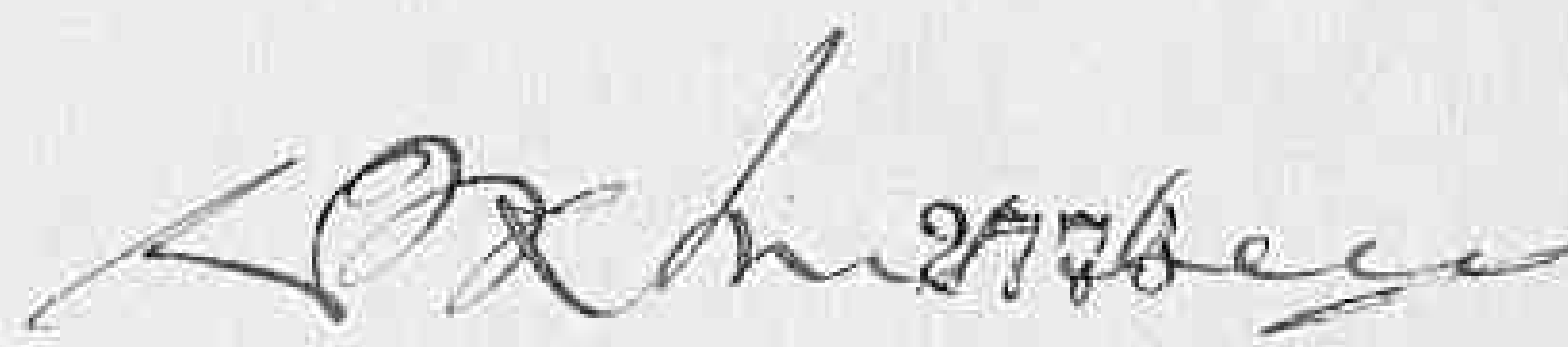
