SUPPLY OF OXYGEN TO ITALIAN STATE RAILWAYS BY

With reference to your letter AC/5578/IND of 8th November 1945, addressed to S.A.P.I.O. Taranto, I would inform you that the plant is under the control of the Royal Navy, who took over the charge from the Army on the 24th June, 1944.

2. The factory, which has two oxygen production units is capable, when both are in operation, of producing 300,000 cubic feet of oxygen per week, but the main unit is seldom in production owing to inherent faults in design and the mainstay is the auxiliary unit built up from a bombed plant within the last 14 months.
3. The output of oxygen over the last eighteen months has averaged 120,000 cubic feet per week, the majority of which is used in the Arsenale in Taranto and at Franco Tosi's Shipbuilding Yard.
4. Although no date can yet be given for the derequisitioning of the factory, this will probably take place before the end of this year.

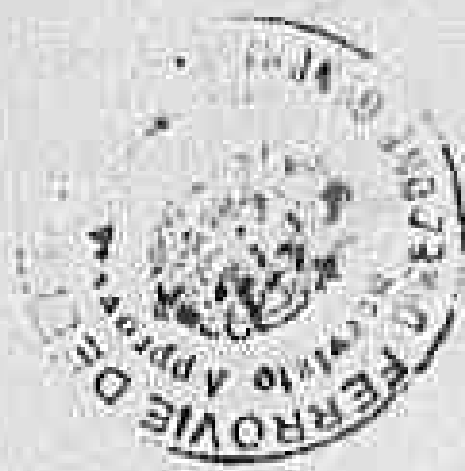

Will you please note the following instruction regarding the issue of Industrial Gases to users in the ROME Area.

"Due to the fact that our 329 TSD TIBURTINA will shortly be closing down, it will no longer be possible for contractors working on repairs to track, electrification, bridges, projects, etc., to draw their oxygen and acetylene requirements against our allocation for the ROME Area through the intermediary of our depot.

Contractor's requirements will be screened at this HQ and an indent duly authorised by a responsible Officer of the corresponding technical branch will then be handed to the contractor concerned for issue by you on a one for one basis to be arranged.

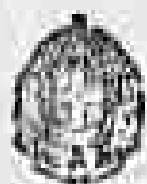

 - ii. For Industrial Gases obtained from static plants controlled by British Army - where plants are staffed entirely by civilians, payment will be made by the civilian purchasing the gas direct to the civilian firm operating the plants. Army contract prices will be used in all cases; these will vary from month to month and can be obtained from ADOS, C.P. & P.(Italy) Ordnance. Where plants are operated by 94 CGD personnel, it will be the responsibility of the local ALCOM representative to collect and account to the proper authority for all payments due from civilian purchasers. Ord(Br) will not effect any financial adjustment whatsoever. Prices will be obtained from OC, 94 C.G.D.

2. Until such time as we are satisfied that requirements for the Bari Compartimento can be made available to the I.S.R. without difficulty, we shall continue to enter a bid to cover the estimated consumption.

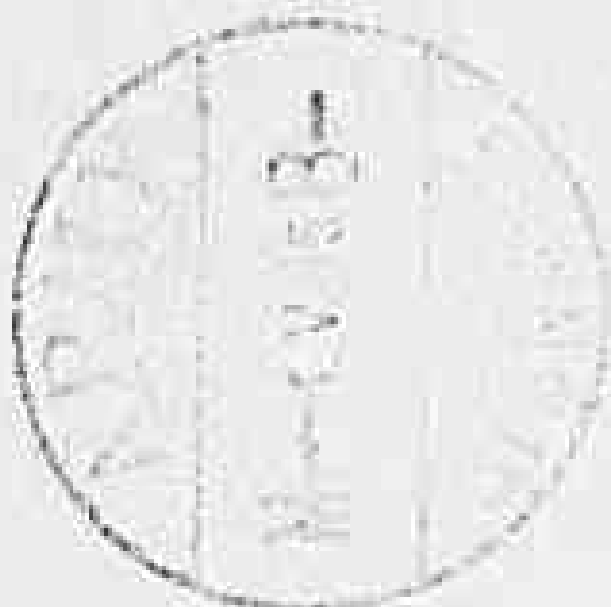

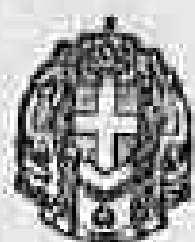

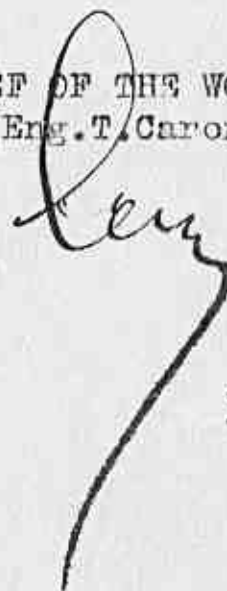
