TO : Director,Trans.Sub-Commission ACC.

1. Reference your letter dated 14 August regarding above subject no file.
2. Following is the status of the movement of these tanks to the mainland:
 - (a) 2 tanks at Messina are ready for shipment and railway is being instructed today to ship them to ISR store yards Poggioreale.
 - (b) 1 is enroute to Messina and same instructions are being issued as in (a).
 - (c) 1 is in the shop at Catania and will be ready to move to Messina within five days.
 - (d) 2 are at Palermo awaiting repairs,work being delayed account oxygen not available.
 - (e) 2 are at Simeto under ground digging operations commenced Sept.4th.
