Subject. Central Umbria Railway.

Ref. conversation Col. Lindberg - Major Fricker, the position of this railway is as follows :-

1. It is now operating the 40 kilometres between TERNI and TODI with 2 locomotives, 12 goods trucks, 8 passenger trucks.
2. It will have to close down by WEDNESDAY NOV.8th. for want of coal, which it needs 2 1/2 tons a day minimum. This is mixed in equal proportions with lignite. Arrangements have been made locally for the production of the necessary lignite.
3. It is requested that, if approved, the Transportation Sub-Commission A.C.C. may telephone authority to the Officer supervising the Steel Works, TERNI or the R.T.O., TERNI, authorising drawing coal from either of these Depots as a temporary measure, until a permanent system is authorised and to prevent the sudden closing of the railway.
4. The value of the railway is
  - (a) Military.  
It is carrying the 300,000 tiles required by the Steel Works to re-roof their factories many hundreds of their workmen, and some of their technical equipment from S.Gemini. This factory is turning out about 6000 tons of steel a month on Army orders.
  - (b) TERNI City Re-building.  
Terni population has grown from 1200 (before occupation) to 57,000 (today). It was bombed continuously for 6 months and practically the only present available source of building is carried by this railway from the factory at MARCIANO.
  - (c) WHEAT.  
Todi is a wheat centre at present, the wheat from here for export to RIETI is being carried by road to ASSISI, railed to TERNI and then sent by road to Rieti. It would save a lot of transport and expense if it was railed direct to TERNI by the Central Railway Umbria, and while this is realised, it cannot be arranged while there is uncertainty as to its continuance.
5. Coal for the continuance of this railway has already been requested on Demand for Controlled Materials form on Oct. 20th.

There is no doubt that if this railway closes down, there will be a slowing up of factory production, causing unnecessary hardship to TERNI town, and waste money, fuel, and tyres of our already overstrained road transport system

1. The Umbria Railroad is an important local line which connects the cities of Terni and Perugia. At the present time, the line is open and functioning between Terni and Todi.

2. The company has an available supply of coal to continue operations for only one week. A request for one hundred tons of bituminous coal as required per month has been made on Form Mat.10.

3. In the present emergency, the railroad could continue to operate if two tons of coal could be released per day from the Terni, Società dell'Industria ed Elettricità.

4. Lt. Simpson at the Steel mill has informed us that this amount of coal can be released upon authority of your office.

5. This railroad is of extreme local importance for the following reasons.

(a) The transportation of workmen to and from their homes along the line to the Steel mill at Terni whose output goes exclusively to the Army.

(b) The transportation of tools and supplies from the storage house at Sangemini to the Steel factory at Terni.

(c) Transportation of Lignite, when the mine is in operation, to the mill.

(d) The transportation of materials for the repair of bridges and buildings in Terni and vicinity.

(e) The delivery of food products and other supplies to the towns situated along the line.

(f) It is now necessary to delivery grain from Todi to Assisi by autotrucks for shipment to Rome. POI supplies could be conserved if shipment were made on the Umbria railroad to Terni and thence to destination.

6. Under these circumstances, request release of two tons of bituminous coal per day from Terni, Società dell'Industria ed Elettricità pending approval of our Mat.10.



1. Reference is to your letter Nov. 3/117 of 1 Sept. 44.
2. It seems most desirable that the correct procedure in such cases should be fully understood.
3. By General Order APMG No. 60 of 22 October 43 the entire responsibility for rehabilitation of all railway lines in Italy is vested in the Director General, Military Railway Service, except in such cases where he hands over responsibility to ACC.
4. In this particular case, the Provincial Commissioner Region IV ACC wrongly referred the matter to No. 3 Beach Group Commander, and it is not clear why the latter was notified to advise the Provincial Commissioner to submit his request to ACC Headquarters.
5. Your request to ACC to give authority for the opening of the line is not apparently based on military requirements and the responsibility for civilian requirements is entirely one for ACC.
6. This Sub-Commission, with the consent of the Director General Military Railway Services would test the line for operation, and ascertain fully the need of the line compared with other applications in hand. There is, in fact, little habilitation between Acquasparta and Terni, and we have at all times to watch movements of black market traffic and, as in this case, offering facilities for refuse and repairs and movement which causes so much concern both to movements and to the Director General Military Railway Service.
7. The merits of this line and its fitness to carry traffic will be investigated, but it is desired to place on record the correct procedure, in order that future cases may

5. Your request to AGC to give authority for the opening of the line is not apparently based on military requirements and the responsibility for civilian requirements is entirely one for AGC.

6. This Sub-Commission, with the consent of the Director General Military Railway Services would test the line for operation, and ascertain fully the need of the line compared with other applications in hand. There is, in fact, little habilitation between Acquasparta and Terni, and we have at all times to watch movements of black market traffic and, as in this case, offering facilities for refugee and repatriate movement which causes so much concern both to Movements and to the Director General Military Railway Service.

7. The merits of this line and its fitness to carry traffic will be investigated, but it is desired to place on record the correct procedure, in order that future cases may be dealt with through proper channels.

2. INASMUCH AS THIS SERVICE CAN BE ESTABLISHED WITHOUT ANY CALL ON M.R.S. RESOURCES OR ANY INTERFERENCE WITH MILITARY TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS AND WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT IT BECOMES AN A.C.C. RESPONSIBILITY, WE AUTHORIZE THE REOPENING FOR CIVILIAN USE OF THE PRIVATE RAILWAY BETWEEN TERMI AND AQUASPARTA.
3. HOWEVER, BECAUSE TERMI IS AN IMPORTANT STATION ON THE RAILROAD FROM A MILITARY VIEWPOINT AND THE RUNNING OF THESE TRAINS INTO TERMI COULD CAUSE SOME INTERFERENCE WITH MILITARY RAILWAY OPERATIONS, IT IS REQUIRED THAT A STOP BOARD BE ERECTED SOME 200 YARDS FROM THE JUNCTION WITH THE I.S.R. RAILS AT TERMI, AND THAT PRIVATE LINE TRAINS BE REQUIRED TO STOP AT THAT BOARD FROM WHICH POINT THEY WILL BE PILOTED INTO THE STATION BY M.R.S. PILOTS.

The Prefettura, Communes, Institutions and private concerns have suggested to us the quick reactivation of the railroad service between Terni and Acquasparta. After the German retreat, we have made the necessary repairs. We did this also because encouraged by you when some time ago we came to your office.

We have made agreement with the Terni concern for the temporary use of their locomotive which will be good for the limited service we may establish.

We send you this letter to have your consent on this program. It is futile to illustrate the advantages that would derive from this plan, because for the poor housing conditions in Terni it is necessary for many people to come daily to this center from all the surrounding villages causing this way a traffic jam in the many roads so much needed for the movement of the Allied Forces and equipment.
