SUBJECT : Baiano Quarry.

Reference to your desire to operate the quarry at Baiano, I attach herewith copy of a letter received from the Undersecretary of Communications. As telephoned to your office on 6 June '44, authority is given for you to operate the quarry.

The amount of tonnage which can be lifted is approximately 80 tons daily over the section.

You will note that in para 3, the letter from the Undersecretary for Communications, a suggestion is made that the Cava Schiava be used.

Perhaps you would investigate the proposal and say which of the two quarries you prefer to operate. It is recalled this letter was written in the 6 Jan'y but misdelivered.

SUBJECT Cave of Baiano.

1. Authorization for the utilization of the Cave of Baiano, which is administrated by the firm Di Pietro Carlo and is joined by Decauville to the Naples - Nola - Baiano line's Baiano Station.

2. a) It is possible to use the Decauville and the existing machineries. The implantations are active.

3. We suggest however to use the Cave Schiaver (administrated by Mr. Marconigliano), which is joined by rail to Cimitile Station, of the above mentioned line, and has a larger potentiality.

4. The Secondary Meridional Railways Society (settled in Naples, 387 Corso Garibaldi), which keeps the Naples - Nola - Baiano railway can effect in the evening, after passengers service finishing, the transport of the loaded cars to Pomigliano and of the void to Baiano or into the Cave Schiava.

From Baiano it is possible to transport daily 8 cars of 10 tons.

From the Cave Schiava 12 cars of 10 tons. Only one of these transports may be effected every night.

5. For the negotiations it is necessary you address yourselves to the firms keeping the Caves and to the Secondary Meridional Railways Society (Naples, 387, Corso Garibaldi).

2. Will you please say whether permission may be given
 - (a) To operate the quarry internally by means of Deceville railway.
 - (b) To have the use of the machinery and plant already existing in the quarry.
 - (c) The maximum tonnage lift which could be made daily, between the quarry and TALONA. *Pomigliano*
3. With regard to the machinery, although I understand this is not in a state of repair, the Military Authorities are prepared to put it into working order.
4. Although the line is used for a passenger service between Baiano and Naples in the morning and evening, the stone could be handled during the day time when the passenger services are not operating. Will you please say approximately at what times motive power could be provided to convey the stone to Talona.
5. As the matter is urgent please reply as soon as possible.

1. An inspection has been made of the spur line from the Circumvesuviana R.R. to the quarry near Schiava. At the present time there is quite an ammunition dump stored on the right-of-way, blocking the line.

2. Inasmuch as the R.R. is used only to serve the quarry and the British Army is using the quarry to obtain stone for road construction, it appears that the ammunition dump can remain as is, for the time being.

SUBJECT : Light Railroad, Naples - Baiano.
TO : Internal Transportation Sub Commission, A.C.C.
A.F.H.Q.

1. With reference to the inquiry by Major Mole as to the advisability of permitting part of this 95 cm gauge railroad between Cittiano and Baiano to be used as storage space for shells, attention is drawn to the following considerations.
2. This line is carrying 7,000 passengers per day to and from Naples, most of them being employed at the Docks and on other work essential to the Army and Civilian needs, 18 trains per day being worked.
3. It is also used for bringing food into Naples, including potatoes, and this traffic will increase as produce becomes available.
4. In view of the important service this light railroad is performing, it is essential that it should be kept open unless absolute military necessity overrides these points.

SUBJECT: 9 metre gauge lines beules to Beiano.

1. Reference letter 29 Dec 43 from D.C.M.R.B., addressed to you, copy to ACC AFHQ Adv. Adm. Ech., passed to this sub Commission attention is drawn to the following consideration.
2. This line is now transporting by 18 trains per day, 7,000 passengers to and from Maples, most of which are employed in the Docks, or work essential to Army and Canadian needs.
3. It also brings food into Maples including potatoes and this traffic is increasing as more produce becomes available.
4. In view of the very important service this light railway is performing, it is considered essential that it should continue to operate unless absolute military necessity overrides the above facts.

Subject: Meter Gauge Lines

To: A.S.C., Hqs. 57 Area (Br.)

1. Yours 23 December, file G-514, reference meter gauge railway paralleling highway from Ciabito toward Avellino from map reference 46596 to 47305.

2. This line is of no military importance, is electrified but at present has no power or telephone communications. It is more or less a suburban line serving a quarry at Reine where the line terminates. However, the Director of the Societa Ferrovie Circumvesuvia who operates this line, stated Colonel Hanson of A.S.C. recently called on him and promised assistance in getting the line back in operation for serving the civilian public.

3. so far as the Military Railway service is concerned there is no objection to the use of this line for the storage of ammunition between the points stated but it is our view that before blocking this line you should confer with A.S.C. (A.S.C.) and definitely establish that the railroad will not be required for civilian purposes.
