MEMORANDUM

17 Sept. 1945.

SUBJECT: Threatened Strike Private
Railway Benevento-Cancello.

1. Major Ping of the Rail Division of the Transportation Sub-Commission reported to this Sub-Commission that a strike of the workers employed by the above described railway was scheduled to take effect on 9th Sept. 1945.

2. Major Ping introduced to this Sub-Commission the director of the Railway Sig.Comm. Umberto PERROTTA who confirmed that a notice had been posted in Benevento calling for a strike effective 9th September.

3. The C.G.I.L. were advised of the position and invited to investigate.

4. C.G.I.L. delegates attended at this Sub-Commission and reported that it had been agreed by the parties to investigate the position through the medium of an arbitration Board consisting of the following:-

Ing. VANZI of the Industrialists' Union of Naples;
Sig. Pietro DILETTO, Secretary of the Ferro-tramvieri Federation for the Campania region;

Ing. SAGGESE, director of Railways Branch of Naples,
representative of the Italian Government. C.A.
C.I.

5. It was indicated that Signor Perrotta was opposed to such action.

6. In these circumstances it was suggested to the C.G.I.L. representatives that they should approach the Italian Government on the matter.

7. The Rail Division of the Transportation Sub-Commission were advised accordingly.
