SUBJECT : Steels for working purposes.

We have in our stores but recently and at times no stocks or either rolled iron material or profile-iron and billets needed for our railways dependencies.

1) The markets at home and angles do not offer any possibility to make up for such shortage through urgent purchases even of variants not thoroughly answering our requirements.

In order to prevent our workshops from delaying or discontinuing the working which is done on, as it has already been pointed out, we have asked the Ilva Co whether they could supply us, within a short time, through their factories at Banchi (Naples) and Torre Annunziata, 1,000 tons of said steel materials.

3) In the Ilva Co. have replied that our request can be complied with only on authorization from your Command.

4) The said quantity of 1,000 tons could be supplied in different times, starting with a lot of 200 tons, in sizes as shown in the attached specification.

5) In this way we should be in a position to meet all such requests as will be addressed to us by the interested dependences, without having to rely on the available stock of your Command.

2. In response to early requests (for forces 100,000-10) for release of glass for purchase by Italian State Railways, advice was received that glass was not a controlled item and could be purchased wherever found. It has not been found in any substantial quantity.
2. There is attached copy of letter from I.S.R. describing their needs for glass and the difficulties met in trying to fill their needs, together with a suggestion for reactivation of production plants, specifically that of Firm Scierre at Ponte Galeria and that the production of that plant be used first to meet the initial requirements of I.S.R.
3. We have no information as to the necessity for or the possibility of the portion less remedied suggested by I.S.R. and therefore must submit it without specific recommendation. However, it is resurfaced that the railway's need for glass is acute, and request is made for whatever action is consistently possible toward development of source of supply of glass for railway needs. It is estimated that 150,000 sq.m. is needed to meet the present acute needs.
4. Will you please advise what the prospects are as to this supply.

IN REPLY QUOTE: R4/ENG/450.2(d)

The Ferrovia del Nord running from ROME to VITERBO recently gave me a copy of a report dated 16th August at my request.

It was asking for Extra Electricity and mentioned that an average of 1200 persons were travelling daily and brought back food on average of 20 Kg per person, and claimed it as a valuable asset to Rome Food Supply. Assuming each person weighs 60 kg, - a goods train could carry more than 4 times as much - .

Enquiries made at^a Technical Electrical inspection a few days ago show that the majority of passengers now travelling do so to collect food to bring back. A most uneconomical way. -

It is brought to your notice with the suggestion that Goods traffic only be allowed with perhaps room for a few passengers if there was surplus accommodation.

Goods Traffic would increase Electric Current for 8 hours instead of 6 as at present. -

With the present wasteful use of the railway there would appear no justification for extra Electricity, but if economically used for goods you might be able to put up a very strong case.

The railway is reported in satisfactory running condition the company are submitting plans for replacement of temporary bridge by a permanent one. It will be examined on receipt. - Reconstruction of permanent bridge over TIBER is progressing. -
