We are informed by our personnel that the Military Police and the drivers of Allied vehicles insist on requesting that they keep open the enclosure bars of our crossings on highways when trains are approaching the road or when they are passing through. They claim that flagging or red signals is a sufficient warning.

We do not know whether this is a new rule or merely an initiative of individual service men to speed up traffic. But, involving as it is the safety of the road and railway traffic, we would appreciate it very much to receive from you proper instructions on the matter.

1. I have received a complaint from Mediterranean Allied Air Forces that a grade crossing on the Piedimonte d'Alife railway at S.MARIA CAPUA is entirely unprotected by gates, and unguarded.
2. A Diesel locomotive, on 18 Dec., approached this crossing, unseen and unheard by an Air Force truck driver, following another truck. The locomotive lights only became visible to the driver when the crossing was reached.
 Both engine and truck were able to stop immediately; slight contact resulting.
3. This situation is extremely dangerous and road traffic must be protected.
 Will you please take the matter up with the private railway concerned and request adequate protection be provided at once, by means of crossing gates and/or watchman.
4. Please inform me of results.



SUBJECT : Level Crossings on Line, Marni-Gastia

1. Reference is to attached papers.
2. It is not clear why Movements Eighth Army requested AMC Eighth Army to arrange for level crossings to be guarded on Military train routes, as it is usual for all such arrangements to be made by post.
3. Please note that AMC Region IV took action with AMG Provincial Commissioner on Perugia and Terni, but there is no indication that the necessary crossing keepers have been put into service.
