TO : A.C.C., TRANSPORTATION SUB-COMMISSION
ATTENTION: COLONEL D. S. ADAMS

1. REFERENCE YOUR ACC TN/26 LETTER OF 12 SEPTEMBER.
2. TRAVELLERS TO WHOM YOU REFER CANNOT CONSISTENTLY BE CONSIDERED AS OTHER THAN ITALIAN CIVILIANS. IT IS NOT POSSIBLE, THEREFORE, TO SET UP ANY SPECIAL FACILITIES FOR TRAVEL, SO FAR AS M.R.S. IS CONCERNED.
3. THERE ARE CURRENTLY CIVILIAN TRAINS OPERATING TO MOST OF AREAS SHOWN AND THAT YOU ARE FAMILIAR WITH THESE IS INDICATED BY FACT THAT TRAIN DEPARTURES ARE SHOWN ON LIST ACCOMPANYING YOUR LETTER.
4. WHEN VOYAGE IS ACTUALLY UNDERTAKEN HEAD OF EACH GROUP MAY WELL BE GIVEN A LETTER, ADEQUATELY TRANSLATED INTO ITALIAN, SIGNED BY A RANKING OFFICER OF A.C.C., AND WELL EMBELLISHED WITH SEALS, RUBBER STAMPS AND LIKE TO MAKE IMPRESSION. THESE LETTERS CAN BE PRESENTED, FOR WHAT THEY ARE WORTH, TO LOCAL RAILWAY TICKET-SELLERS.
5. YOU WILL APPRECIATE, CERTAINLY, FACT THAT IT IS INCREASINGLY UNDESIREABLE TO SHOW PREFERENCE BETWEEN VARIOUS CLASSES OF ITALIAN CIVILIANS. IT IS HIGHLY UNDESIREABLE THAT THIS PRACTICE, WHICH UNFORTUNATELY HAS HAD "BLESSING" OF SOME ALLIED OFFICERS, BE CONTINUED.

MEMORANDUM to Col.D.S. Adams

SUBJECT: Statistical Survey

1. I attended Meeting on Statistical Survey project, which was briefly outlined by Lieut.Hicks.

2. It is intended to arrange almost immediately a Survey to determine in some measure the present position of Italy, both socially and industrially.

3. The idea is to use Italian personnel to collate answers to specific questions, down to commune level, by

- a) personal enquiry of individuals
- b) contact with commune officials

Plans will include the asking of fairly exhaustive questions to every tenth family in one fifth of each commune.

4. A further Survey will be made concurrently by sending 1938 Industrial Census Forms to industries indicated, with a request for indication of present day answers to the questions shown thereon.

5. Questions to Lieut.Hicks as to transport revealed that it is proposed to ask as to equipment made in the past, garages, owners of transport and present charges for conveyance (including 'black market'). It is also proposed to have a 72 hours road block and conduct investigations thereon.

6. From the discussion and the outline given, I could not see that Rail transport, because of its overall nature, could usefully pose questions, but I felt that road transport might usefully propose questions, both in regard to passenger and freight traffic, due in the main to the localised nature of that form of transport.
