1. D.M.R.S. and Transportation Sub Commission recently made an inspection of the "INDUSTRIA CHIMICHE NAZIONALI RIUNITE Soc. An." at Cesano in Roma, with the view of having cars repaired at this plant.

2. It is doubtful if this would be worthwhile owing to the layout at the plant, however a large supply of materials were found there which are needed for repairs to rolling stock in Porto Maggiore, Wagons Lits, Santa Bibiana, etc. The material found is as follows: 3271

- (a) Approx 1000 cu. meters of hard seasoned wood which is suitable for repair of railway stock, average size 35 cm. x 6 cm. x 5 m.
 - (b) a large stock of varnish of various colours, with materials available to make further supplies.
 - (c) 34 electric motors of various sizes, all in working order.
 - (d) A large stock of sheet metal suitable for repairing metal wagons.
 - (e) A large quantity of glass suitable for passenger stock. Maximum size 1.5 m x 50 cm.
 - (f) Very large stock of lubricating oils are available. You can secure samples and make tests of this oil.
3. Please make arrangements with this firm to purchase the quantities of the above mentioned materials that you require, directly from them.
4. The glass and varnish are in two underground galleries so have your representatives be sure to see this material.
5. Give this matter preferred attention.

1. I append you copy of a report dated 26 Nov 44 from Lt BOWIE of AC on the above subject.
2. As regards the possibility of having wagons repaired, I am doubtful if it would be worth it though I will look into this with the ISR and report to AC later.
3. As regards the materials mentioned, the items I have starred are on very short supply and are of vital interest to us for repairs to rolling stock in Porto Maggiore, Wagon Lit, San Bibiana, etc. I should be glad therefore if you would arrange with AC that 75% of the stocks be purchased by the ISR and transferred to their Carriage and Wagon works stores for use on our behalf.

- 3. All wood working machines have been removed by the Germans, but the Gero who conducted me around the works informed me that the firm has other wood working machines in ROME.
- 4. Stored in one building is approx 1000 cu metres of hard seasoned wood suitable for repair of railway stock, average size 25cm x 6cm x 6m.
- 5. There is also a large stock of varnish of various colours, and I was informed that materials were available to make further supplies.
- 6. There are some 34 electric motors of various sizes, which are all in working order.
- 7. The firm has large stocks of sheet metal suitable for repairing metal wagons.
- 8. There is a large quantity of glass suitable for passenger stock at this plant, max size 1.5m x 50cm.
- 9. Very large stocks of lubricating oils are available; several samples be tested.
- 10. The railway line from this station (GRSANO) to ROME is open and there are a number of good sidings throughout the plant, but none under cover. The firm suggest transporting wagons on special bogies into buildings where they might be repaired under cover.

Re/ Offer for works of regaining & repairs to railway material and motor-cars.

On the platforms of the railway stations of Rome, Cesano and other ones of the zone, there are many railway waggons needing repairs of various kind. As we possess a large mechanical workshop, at a short distance from Cesano Station, connected by junction to the same station, we beg to request you to give us the repairs of all rolling material in that zone. The manoeuvres for the transportation of waggons from the platform where they are into our factory can be done by ourselves with our own transportation means.

The B.P.D. Company (Bombrini-Parodi-Delfino of Colleferro), owner of many materials now stopping at Cesano, partially laden on the waggons & partially dispersed in the under-lying ballasting has requested us to shelter these materials in our factory, what might be easily done if the waggons containing the materials were passed to us for repairs, as previously requested.

We also request to do the regaining of waggons now out of use also because, by dismantling them, we could get parts to be used for repairing other vehicles of the same kind.

For your information we give you the following details concerning the mechanical workshop where the repairs would be made:

- 1) - connection with the railway station of Cesano by a ring junction of about 2 Kms., with the possibility to receive & to shunt more than 100 waggons,
- 2) - the waggons received by us might also stop in the trench, sufficiently hidden & protected. Our factory is provided with suitable antiraid shelters.
- 3) - though the considerable quantity of machines removed by the Germans, we still possess the following machinery:

Concerning the joiners' workshop we now dispose of only one building, as the Germans removed all machines. But if you give us some work we will care to buy & settle promptly the machines for working of wood, as we have always done this work together with the mechanical works.

Our factory might also be suitable for remaining & repairing motor-car materials in general, having room & hangars enough for storage, shunting & assembling.

We are at your disposal for any detail & remain, with kindest regards.
