SUBJECT : Report on locomotive repair sheds and equipment at
Campobasso.

1. LOCO. SHED. AND SHOP BUILDINGS.

The sheds, and shops, which have been heavily damaged are in the course of repairs, but there is still a great deal of work to be done, most of this work seems to have been neglected so that the Station Buildings could be brought up to a place of some standard, this latter work is nearly completed.

The loco shed consists of four tracks, which have inspection pits for nearly the entire length, two of the tracks are under cover, while repairs to the roof on the other two tracks has been started, but no work is being carried out at the moment.

The repair shops and offices have been nearly gutted and only three rooms have any covering, these are being used to store what remains of the equipment and some salvaged materials.

A separate building which was used to house the LOCO WHEEL LATHE is badly damaged, and only part of the wall remains standing.

There is an oil storage shed which is very little damaged, and has five tanks, three of 5000 litres, one of 2500 litres and another of 1500 litres.

2. EQUIPMENT etc.

IN THE LOCO SHED, There are 6 electric loco jacks said to be in working order, and 2 electric loco jacks which require heavy repairs.

IN THE SHOPS there are 2 (10 Ton) hand operated jacks.

IN THE STATION SIDINGS there are 2 (20 Ton) hand operated jacks. In the wheel-lathe shop there is the ground frame and a couple of spindles remaining of what was once a LOCO WHEEL LATHE, and even the ground frame is badly damaged by explosives.

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IN THE LOCO REPAIR SHOPS there is the following equipment:-
