1. Medical Section (British) state that certain of the medical stores requested in the above letter could be made available to ISR. As Italian civil agencies are not normally entitled to medical supplies from military sources, they are only able to issue on the recommendation of G5 AFHQ or Allied Commission.
2. G5 have reminded us that the proper channel for ISR to obtain these supplies is through the appropriate Italian Ministries. They are therefore not willing to authorize issues from military stocks unless there is evidence either that ISR have been unfairly treated in distribution or that there is a serious shortage of medical supplies.
3. A copy of G5 letter M-3 dated 8 Oct 45 to Allied Commission is attached. It is also being forwarded to Transportation Sub-Commission, Allied Commission to ensure that Public Health Sub-Commission should be made fully aware of the importance of these supplies to ISR.

Three I.S.R. Department doctors were appointed to medical service at the railway centre of Civitavecchia, until last June.

At present no one of them is authorized to reside at Civitavecchia.

Doct. Sarno Paolo, who is also parish doctor, has been appointed by the Town to perform his duty at S. Marinella, on behalf of the refugees of Civitavecchia. Doct. Sleiter Umberto, a parish doctor, too, resides at S. Marinella, where from he is carried every day in the outskirts of Civitavecchia, in a locality named Cisterna, and he is carried back home at night.

Doct. Croce Gaetano, who is a free professional doctor at Civitavecchia, on his return from military service, had to remain in Rome, because he could not obtain the authorization to go back to Civitavecchia, where he might live in his own house, which has been only partially damaged.

In order to assure a sufficiently regular performance of the medical service at Civitavecchia, it is necessary that at least one out of the three mentioned I.S.R. Department doctors be definitively resident at said locality. We beg you, therefore, to authorize Doct. Croce Gaetano to have again his residence at Civitavecchia.
