1. WAGONS FOR COAL SHIP
Highside wagons in very short supply. Major Blair stated he was endeavouring to obtain releases from Sicily.

2. LOCOMOTIVES FROM SICILY
Three arrived ex Sicily this morning and it is expected a further four will be worked over during the day.
Capt Tombwell suggested these locomotives work forward the coal wagons and thus not interfere with normal existing power position.
AGREED
3. ELECTRIC LIGHTING AT SAN EUFEMIA L. STATION
RMO at San Eufemia L complained of lack of Station lighting facilities. Major Blair asked to take up.

4. MOVE EX SICILY
Big road move expected ex Sicily. Wish to work vehicles over before ferryboat is taken off. Capt. Wombwell arranging unit to commence to move immediately and increased ferry services until move of unit completed.

Reference para 2 of Conference held 5 Oct. These have since been found and instructions given for them to be returned to Sicily.

Special refugee train ex Rome blocked North of 2nd Naples. Not expected to arrive here before 10th or 11th Oct. Major Blair to advise all concerned these refugees will probably have to be held until the 15 Oct.
