1. Distribution and Control of Petroleum Products for civilian use.

All plans have been made after several conferences with CIP and Italian Government Officers, for the registration of motor vehicles, and users of petroleum products. Forms and instructions for regulation were not received, so that it has been recommended that distribution and regulations be continued for May as in the past, and that the new system be effective as of June 1. All applications by users must be in by May 10 if this suggested extension of time is approved and all details for control and processing will be complete and established by May 31. Local officials are of the opinion that an earlier effective date cannot be used.

2. Truck and Bus traffic.

Transportation of freight and personnel is limited because of shortage of tires and spare parts. Some correspondence has been had with Headquarters covering needs in Region 6 but no tires have been obtained. A survey was made of tires on hand in the Italian Army stores. There are approximately 1500 tires, of large sizes, on immobilized vehicles in storage parts near Paulotino. Abbasarta, and Monti; and about 500 tires, new, in storage near Abbasarta. These tires are to service about 5000 Italian Army vehicles. Principally trucks and none are available for civilian use. The Army (Italian) had only about 100 small tires in stock. Bus lines operate only 32 buses out of a total of 157 on hand, because of tire shortage. Distribution of mail is seriously handicapped.

3. Railroads. The standard gauge railroad is operating to its full capacity, principally for military materials and equipment. A supply of imported coal has been received. The narrow gauge railroads are supplied with imported coal only for use in moving necessary civil supplies. Data has been submitted by the Ferrovie State and Meridionale Sardo for materials and supplies needed for

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4. Shipping. Some small ships have come over from Sicily, and effort has been made to set up a schooner pool for trade with Sicily and the Mainland. However, at this time all overseas travel is curtailed and coastal operations only are active.

Routine duties covered movements of civilian supplies by rail and truck, and conferences with Italian Government officers on transportation details.
