1. Attached hereto is a duplicate of a letter to this Sub-Commission, dated 17 January from Societa Generale delle Conserve Alimentari Cirio relating to the molasses at Capua and a copy of our reply thereto.

2. The officials of Cirio inform us that they have made arrangements with COMPARTIMENTO FERROVIE DELLO STATO, Naples, for the repair of the siding to the Capua sugar mill. It is suggested that this agency be urged to complete these repairs promptly in order that the 250 tons of molasses can be moved to Barletta by railway tank wagons available in Barletta.

3. Demands for additional quantities of yeast were put forward at today's meeting of the Food Supply Committee of the AFLAB. These demands are in excess of the total capacity of the two plants now operating, and we urge that the matter of the de-requisition of the Naples yeast factory be pursued vigorously.


Please give the matter consideration and advise me what is decided.
