SPEED LIMITS

13. Sub-areas will establish their local speed limits in built up areas as they consider necessary. Any such speed limits will be strictly observed by all vehicles.

CONVOY MARKING

14. Each convoy will display a blue flag on the leading vehicle. Green flags on the last vehicle will not be flown by any other vehicle in the convoy or not, with the exception of vehicles of forward units, and from Comd, headquarters vehicles and ambulances.
