SUBJECT : Movement of Food-stuffs.

1. Whilst I was Provincial Commissioner of the Bari Province, Military Unit Commanders in the Province rendered valuable assistance by permitting W.D. vehicles, when not required for military purposes, to convey food stuffs for the civil population.

2. As there was no order permitting the military to convey this food-stuff on behalf of ACC, I wrote to the Area Commander expressing my great appreciation of the valuable help given, and represented that unit commanders would feel easier in their minds if authority was given to them to allow W.D. vehicles to transport food-stuffs, whenever such vehicles were not at the time required for military purposes.

3. The Area Commander replied by ^{saying} ~~said~~ he regretted he had no power to give such authority to unit commanders, but that so far as he was concerned he had no objection to the practice continuing unofficially.

4. I feel it would be of immense value and assistance to this Sub-Commission if authority could be given to all District Commanders, permitting W.D. Vehicles to be used for short haulage of foodstuff to the civilian population when ever W.D. Vehicles were not being used for military commitments.

1. Contents of the above letter have been noted and the appointment of Capt. Smith to Region III is appreciated.
2. This HQ will advise you as promptly as possible of all developments in the Tn situation in Eighth Army area. It is considered in principle, however, that it is your responsibility to work out in conjunction with AAI the broad forward plan for the maint of AMG Eighth Army, indicating the ry lines, ports and rd routes on which we should count. This HQ will then work out with Q locally detailed requirements as to Rhds, tonnages and location of depots; but as in the case of the armies, so in that of AMG the lower formations must look to their higher counterpart to formulate and advise the overall maint plan.
