1. Receipt is acknowledged of letter by S.A.M. date: 22 May 1944, requesting establishment of bus service to MATANI and your letter of 26 May requesting comment.

2. It is felt that the establishment of an inter-regional bus service in rightly the function of A.C.C. Headquarters possibly at the request of Region El.Civilian circulation must be held down to a 16 kilometers radius, hence the establishment of bus service to MARIES at this time seems impracticable and the suggestions pressure.

3. The tariff proposed is much too high as compared with other operations in Italy at this time. Eventually a National tariff will be set up under which all shusses will operate.

4. It is noted that S.A.M. evidently has a 25 ton lorry available for commodity transport. This vehicle should be examined immediately by Lt. ASH with an view of taking it into Truck Fool No. 2 under provision of paragraphs 5 and 6, "Instructions for Operation of Motor Pools" issued 15 hay 1944, copy to your office.

- 1. The 41st Service Group does not have in its possession a bus belonging to the (Sita Societa Italiana Transporti Automobilistici.)
- 2. On April 17, 1944 a requisition was signed by Purchasing and Contracting Officer for one bus No. 324-001432, Fiat 621 R. N. This bus was represented to us as one abandoned by the Germans, which the (Sita Societa Transporti con Automobili) had received permission from Amgot, Avellino to recondition and run.
- 3. We are renting a bus from (Sita Italina Transporti con Automobili.) As we were renting one bus from them, the above requisition was signed in order that they might continue to supply adequate civilian transportation, and not have this bus requisitioned by anyone else. We were not aware of the fact that this bus belonged to another company. We have never used this bus or had it in our possession, and we have no interest in keeping it.
