1. Attached hereto is a release received from AFHQ, which permits the I.S.R. to clear 76 freight cars loaded with steel plates and section in the Venice Region.
2. Please issue the necessary instructions in order that this material may be unloaded from the cars at the earliest possible time.
3. The release of this material is subject to it being of Italian origin, surplus to military requirement and that it will be used in the rehabilitation of the Italian State Railways.
4. The Regional Commissioner, Venezia Region has been advised of the release and notified to safeguard the material until I.S.R. assumes control.
5. Please expedite your instructions and furnish this Hq. with lists of the material contained in the cars.

1. Confirming telephone conversation between Capt. Ping and Capt. London:

2. Herewith, by courier, five (5) copies of lists showing 123 cars in the Rome Area loaded with captured material. It is very essential that these cars be unloaded with all possible haste. Available supply of cars is dwindling rapidly due to increased loading, longer haul, line interruptions, and change in trend of traffic flow, hence the release of these cars is urgent.

3. In line with telephone conversation, please exercise all possible pressure to obtain immediate disposition, furnishing the undersigned advice as to where the various cars should be spotted for unloading.
