SUBJECT: Vehicle Releases - Replacements B.L.R.

To : Headquarters, Allied Control Commission, APO 394.

1. Reference your C/M/101/10 dated 3 Oct 44.
2. The replacement of 43 x 3 ton G.S. Trucks has been discussed with the appropriate AFIC authority and this section has been advised that replacement will be made as soon as theatre stocks permit.
3. The necessity for the replacement of A.C.C. vehicles B.L.R'd, has not been overlooked by the "controlling authority" AFIC, and replacement will be made as the vehicles become available.
4. Reference this H.C. letter T-11, 4 Oct 44, the V.R. notes attached thereto cover partial replacement of the 27 vehicles mentioned in A.C.C. letter C-4/M/101/10 - 16 Sept 44. This matter was discussed C-4 (B) A.C.C. - Lt. Col. Franklin, C-5, AFIC, although it was agreed that 3 tonners would be more practical, it was decided that, in view of the theatre shortage of 3 tonners, the 15 tons should be accepted.

- 1 The condition of a/n vehicle when drawn by a representative of this pool was the same as in appended REME report, and was better than Austin No 4675479 drawn at the same time. This letter vehicle had to be towed in whereas the Bedford made the trip from Rome under its own power. It was decided to keep the Austin as two similar vehicles were awaiting BLR, so that an exchange of parts could be made.
- 2 From personal experience of drawing vehicles from RACC for ACC P&U pool Bovino, it can be stated that the a/n vehicles represent an average of the used vehicles issued, many worse have been received on one occasion 6 finished on tow $\varphi$  out of one release.
- 3 The above conclusion is born out by the fact that in spite of good repair facilities at this pool, out of 69 3 ton British Army vehicles on charge no less than 31 have been condemned by REME as BLR and are at present awaiting replacement.
- 4 In view of the difficulty in obtaining spares and the heavy work to be done, the issue of Class 3 & 4 trucks without prior REME overhaul can only lead to a continuous process of issue, BLR, and replacement a state of affairs most unsatisfactory to all concerned.

3. Nevertheless, the fact remains that the BLR Certificate originally issued and, as stated by you, forwarded to this HQ. sometime in June, cannot be traced here, and must have lost in the post.
4. It is requested that you approach O.C. 641 Service Station, REME, and ask whether he will accept a certificate from this HQ. to the effect that:
  1. This HQ. has never received a BLR Certificate for vehicle No. L 5665977.
  2. No vehicle has been requested or drawn by this HQ. in replacement of vehicle No. L 5665977.
  3. So far as this HQ. is aware, vehicle No. L 5665977 has never been on the strength of ACC.

If O.C. 641 Service Station, REME, agrees to accept this certificate and to proceed with the issuing of a BLR Certificate for vehicle No. L 5605977, this HQ. will furnish same immediately.

1. Reference telephone conversations yesterday afternoon between Capt. Saunders and Capt. Tector.

2. It is requested that a complete and absolutely accurate return of R.D. numbers only of British Commitment Vehicles, be submitted to this C.C. at the earliest possible date. Your list should be based upon the old set-up from Section L.R. i.e. 157 J-boners. Less 20 sent to Region VIII. It is expected that, at present total will not equal 137, owing to R.D.'s, etc. This R.D. illustrates your present total as follows:

Originally 137, less 54 R.D.'s equals 83. Then 26 replacements equals 111.

3. It is not the desire of this R.D. to impose unnecessary work upon you, but a considerable degree of inaccuracy in return of vehicles is causing complete chaos here. Actual and expected examples of these inaccuracies are as follows:

a. Vehicles Nos. 4722190, 4616550, and 1929316 are shown as returns of your current monthly returns. We know that these three vehicles have been declared R.D. and were included in a batch of 29 R.D. certificates sent Q7/08/45 to Q(R) L.R. on 6 August 1944. Furthermore these 27 vehicles were replaced by new numbers on 16 August 1945. Again, vehicles numbers 1929366, 152562, 1367267, 1323426, and 1355576 we know have been declared R.D. These have not yet been reported, but certainly should not appear on your return.

b. Vehicle No. 462358 has been duplicated, appearing once at Naples and once at Salerno. This is inexplicable, and causes completely impossible difficulty in arriving at an accurate total of vehicles on your strength.

5. The following vehicles do not appear on your list at all:

2. It is requested that a complete and absolutely accurate return of W.D. numbers only of British Commitment Vehicles, be submitted to this HQ at the earliest possible date. Your list should be based upon the old set-up for inclusion in the 157 Commanders, less 20 sent to Foreign VIII. It is suggested that, of course, that your present total will not equal 137, owing to losses, etc. This HQ. suggests your present total as follows:

Ordnance 237. less 54 MIA's or 63. Plus 28 replacements equals 111.

3. It is not the desire of this HQ. to impose unnecessary work upon you, but a considerable degree of discourtesy in return of vehicles is causing considerable chaos here. Actual or otherwise not copies of these instructions will be followed:

a. Vehicles Nos. 472290, 461658, and 192934 are shown as runners of your current monthly return. No know that these three vehicles have been declared MIA, and were included in a batch of 29 MIA certificates sent out dated 20 (as) 4/24/43 on 6 August 1944. Furthermore these 29 vehicles were also replaced by new numbers on 16 August 1944. Again, vehicles numbers 1930566, 4525528, 1907267, 1929426, less 1305% to soon have been declared MIA. These have not yet been replaced, but certainly should now appear on your return.

b. Vehicle No. 463528 has been duplicated, appears in one of Ropel's and one at Salvage. This is inexplicable, and requires completely impossible effort to arrive at an accurate total of vehicles on your strength.

- This also is inexplicable since, so far as we know, these vehicles are still running and on your strength
4. Referring to the estimate in para 2 above, our summary of the situation is as follows:

You have submitted a monthly return of 116 British Commitment vehicles of which one is duplicated, equals 115. You have shown eight vehicles which are definitely BLF and should not have appeared. (See para 1 above.) This equals 107. You have included the five Food Sub-Commission vehicles Nos. 216581, 514416, 4878735, 4883972, and 4883976, which were never on your official strength, equals 102. You have failed to show the nine vehicles mentioned in Para 3 sub-para (d), equals 111 as per our estimate in para 2 above.

5. Please forward your comments on the above points together with the list requested in para 1 above.

6. It should be noted that monthly returns need only include these British commitment vehicles. Your 2½ ton GMC vehicles, which are American commitments, are catered for by your Weekly Deadline Reports.






