TO : Hq. Region VIII (Att: Major Sowers)

1. Reference your HVIII/35/32/6 dated 18 Sept. 44.
2. Hq. Southern Region have been requested to expedite delivery of the necessary forms, since these forms are all being printed in Naples.
3. It is pointed out however, that Siena Province has not yet been handed back to the Italian Government, and that it is not therefore correct to state that the lack of forms and gas ration cards encourages truck operation outside the control of the Consorzio Trasporti.
4. The remedy is simple. Confiscate such trucks.
