SUBJECT: January Movements of Food and Agricultural Supplies

TO : Mr. Merritt H. Taylor
Director, Transportation Sub-Commission

1. Based on first quarter estimates there will be no significant changes in requirements or availabilities of the following food items for January as compared to the data given on the charts for December:

Olive oil, Lard, Butter
Citrus Fruit
Salt
Wheat and Barley
Wine
Animal, Fish and Dairy Proteins

2. There will be a fairly uniform reduction of 20 percent in the availability of Perishable Vegetables as compared to the figures on the charts you already have. Since there is no possibility of imports in this group, a similar reduction of 20 percent will have to be made in the requirements, therefore, a uniform 20 percent reduction in the movements shown on your present charts will yield approximately the correct figures for January.

3. A 10 percent reduction in the movements of non-Perishable Vegetables and Nuts will give you the desired figures for January.

4. There are no significant changes in Charcoal and Fuelwood.

5. There will be no Coffee for distribution. The original map on this item was drawn up at a time when there was some discussion of possible imports.

6. There will be no January figures available on agricultural supplies. Items in this category are all dependent on so many factors of import and domestic industry that the program cannot be "firm" until approximately the middle of January at which time we should have very satisfactory figures covering the month of February.
