SUBJECT : Arming of Civilian Guards.

TO : SL, 2675 Regt. AC. ✓

1. With reference to the suggested issue of Rifles to Civilian Guards at the APAC Plant, Via Prenestina, as discussed by Capt. Peterson, Transportation S/C.

2. The Questore of Rome has been interviewed regarding the issue of permits for the Guards to carry arms for the purpose of guarding the above mentioned premises, and he has suggested as follows :-

The Guard who will be in charge should take to the Questore a nominal roll of the Guards who will be employed.

The Questore will give an authorisation and the Guards will then be required to attend the Prefettura and make a formal declaration.

3. This procedure will have the effect of making the Guards regularly appointed watchmen under Italian law, and gives them more authority to properly carry out their functions.

4. The Questore has promised to give every assistance to expedite the matter.
