Subject: G.T. Companies.

1. 1002 G.T. Company has been functioning since the end of December last in the movement of surplus grain from Macerata, Ascoli Piceno and Teramo Provinces to the deficiency Provinces of Aquila, Chieti and Pescara.

2. Detachments have been accommodated at Macerata Ascoli Piceno and Teramo, with Headquarters and workshops at Aquila, and more recently at Guillanova.

3. A telephone message was received from Major Milnes, O.C., 1002 G.T. Company late yesterday afternoon to the effect that two platoons of another G.T. Company -1000- had arrived at Macerata with instructions from the Transportation Sub-Commission to take over from 1002 Company detachments stationed there.

4. Arrangements have been made, therefore, with Major Milnes, subject to approval, that the following procedure shall now operate:-

Macerata.	2 Platoons of 1000 Coy.	60 Vehicles.
Ascoli Piceno	2 Platoons of 1002 Coy.	60 "
Teramo	2 Platoons of 1002 Coy.	60 "

5. One of the platoons working from Teramo may be accommodated at Guillanova, if there is insufficient space at Teramo. From an operational points of view either location is equally suitable.

6. As a result of this new alignment the movement of grain will be considerably expedited and the needs of Aquila Chieti and Pescara Provinces more quickly fulfilled, allowing an immediate opportunity of increasing rail shipments to the south from Cortona.

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7. It is pointed out that no official advice of the expected arrival of the two platoons of 1000 Company was received until today, when the attached signal reached this Headquarters.
