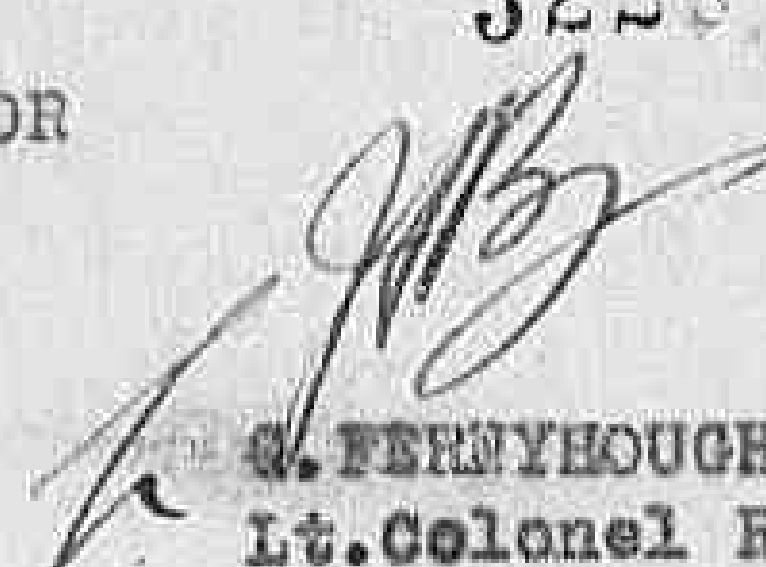

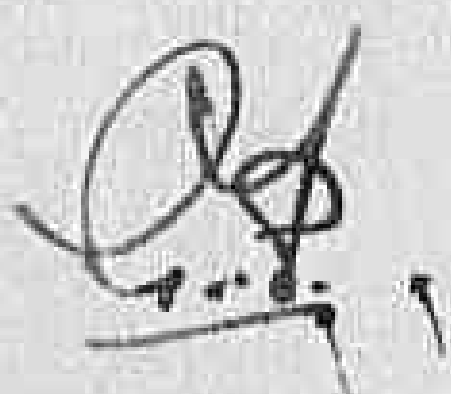

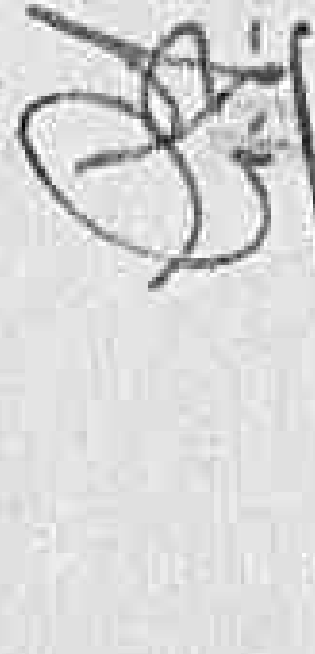

1. At present only 41% of the necessary road lift for civilian supply is being made. The Director of this Sub-Commission has given instructions that the percentage must be improved.

2. In this connection it is necessary to obtain frequent and accurate information of truck availability, haulage operations and commodities moved in all AC/AMG territory. Such data is needed by the Movements and Roads Divisions of the Sub-Commission in order efficiently to control road haulage operations generally and to maintain necessary statistical records.

3. It has therefore been decided to introduce a system of 10 Day Returns which will provide data required in the same form from all Regions, the Motor Transport Group, Allied Commission and E.H.A.C. The returns are:-

- I. 10 Day Truck Status Return.
- II. 10 Day Truck Operations Return.
- III. 10 Day Analysis of Commodities Hauled by Road.
- IV. 10 Day Progress Return of Priority Truck Haulage Programmes.

4. The returns will be compiled for the 10 day periods ending to the 10th, 20th, 30th/31st inclusive in each month and will be submitted to reach this HQ. by the 15th, 25th and 5th of the month. The first returns are required on 25 March. Returns should be rendered in triplicate and addressed to this S/C (Att. Roads Branch)

5. Proformas for each return, together with notes on compilation are attached.

6. Your co-operation in the punctual rendition of the returns is requested.

7. Similar returns will be rendered by M.M.A.C. it has been arranged that their returns for each Compartment shall be handed in to the Transportation or Truck Pool Officer at the nearest A.C. NOTES ON COMPIATION OF 10 DAY RETURNS1. GENERAL

(a) The returns are designed to be used both by AC/AMG Transportation Officers and Units of the M.T. Group, Allied Commission.

(b) W.D. trucks in the returns refer to those operated in AC/AMG Civilian Supply Truck Pools or under command of the M.T. Group. Civilian trucks are those organized in Truck Pools either under AC/AMG or local Office Transport control.

(c) Regional Transportation Officers will be responsible for obtaining returns for civilian trucks in areas where EMAC is not functioning.

2. 10 DAY TRUCK STATUS RETURN

(a) Separate returns are required for (I) 1st Truck Bn by Coys (II) the 4 C.T. Coys by Coys (III) each Region showing separately each W.D. Trucks Pool and each civilian pool.

(b) The "Total Held" figure excludes M.L.R. and Salvaged trucks.

3. 10 DAY TRUCK OPERATIONS RETURN

(a) One return to be submitted for (I) 1 Truck Bn. in total; (II) each C.T. Coy.; (III) each Region showing figures for all W.D. Trucks Pools in total (under coln (b) and all civilian pools in total (under coln (c)).

(b) Difficulty in obtaining data from Civilian pools is appreciated; but Items 7-10 should be procurable.

4. 10 DAY ANALYSIS OF COMMODITIES MOVED BY ROAD

(a) Separate returns are required for (i) each Coy of 1 Truck Bn. (ii) each C.T. Coy. (iii) each W.D. Truck Pool; (iv) each civilian truck pool.

(b) The total number of quintals moved in the 10 day period is required and NOT for each day separately.

(c) The return is divided into 3 sections to show internal movements within Regions; imports and exports. Colns headed "point of Departure" and "Destination" should be left blank at present. No information is required under the headings "FROM" and "TO" in the INTERNAL Section. TOTALS at the bottom of the form should be left blank.

(d) A supply of these forms is enclosed. Minor amendment as per specimen attached will be necessary.

5. 10 DAY PROGRESS RETURN OF PRIORITY TRUCKS MAILAGE PROGRAMMES

(a) This return is needed to check progress of important haulage programmes of priority commodities, such as grain, hemp, saws, sulphur and coal, etc., which are issued from time to time.

(b) It is at present required from:-

(i) Southern Region for the Hemp programme in Naples Province.

(ii) from Abruzzi-Marche Region for grain movements from

(a) Ancona, Pesaro and Macerata Provinces to railheads at Montecarotto, Jesi, Senigallia and Chiaralle (for Rome area);

(b) Macerata, Ascoli and Teramo Provinces to Ortona railhead and Chieti, Pescara and Aquila Provinces (1000, 1002 and 1004 G.T.Coys).

Regional Supply Officer receives these figures.

(iii) From M.T.Group for sulphur movement from Cabernadi mine to Montecarotto railhead (1004 G.T.Coy).

(iv) From M.T. Group for movement of AMG supplies Ancona to Forli (100 G.T.Coy).

(v) From M.T.Group for movement of olive and fruit trees in Florence area (1 Truck Bn.)

(c) Under column (c) and (d) provinces or railheads only are required. Where a programme involves very many different points of origin and destinations column (c) and (d) may be left blank.
