TO : Transportation Sub-Commission, A.C.
(Att. Col. Harris).

1. This Division received an Unblocking Order for a number of tires at Pirelli and Michelin, which Colonel Fitzgerald divided proportionately amongst the various Uffici Trasporti in Lombardia.
2. As of September II, 1945, these Release Orders became valid. But before the tires could all be collected, Commerce Sub-Commission, A.C. blocked all releases.
3. We waited awhile and then Captain Piper wrote to Commerce A.C., TN/I55/379, inquiring as to when we could again collect the tires allotted to us.
4. We received an answer from Commerce, AC/5014/2/MIL, signed by Mr. White, saying that the inventory had been completed and the tires would be released to the Uffici Trasporti through the Comitato Gomma. The letter also stated that they had found irregularities such as tires for civilian automobiles being released for trucks. (Trucks having priority over civilian pleasure cars seems a normal procedure to us, however.)
5. This Division then sent a letter to the Comitato Gomma signed by Lieutenant Houston, asking for release of the remaining tires and stating, quite truthfully, that Mr. White had given us the verbal okay. Comitato Gomma promptly send our man back, saying they would only recognize Mr. White's signature.
6. When we sent the letter up for his signature, he refused to sign, saying there were too many. (60 tires for some 1,000 demands).
7. The point is, as far as we are concerned, that they

7. The point is, as far as we are concerned, that they were previously released to us from Commerce. Our needs, in the meantime, have not diminished by any means. We tried to release them with some kind of system and therefore lose out. Now, are we to get them or not?
8. Perhaps you can enlighten us on the subject.

The Prefect of Siracuse has forwarded to me the copy of a resolution from the Association of motor truck owners of Francoforte asking for the attention of this High Commissioner in order to promptly be supplied with tyres, inner tubes, and other essential accessories, needed to put on the road the greatest possible number of motor vehicles so as to be able to meet the transport needs of the impending citrus campaign in that area.

Should it be impossible as is expected, to assist them quickly and substantially, as required, the a/m hauliers ask to be left free to provide for their supplies of the said items, without having to fear repressions from the police.

Considering the foregoing statements, the A.C. are kindly requested to be lenient towards the action which the a/m hauliers are going to take in order to obtain the supplies they need to put their trucks on the road.

Reference your notes attached and 15.10/ES.

1. This Sub-Commission has been trying for the past few months to organize the authorization forms issued for the use of U.D. tires by civilians.
2. This was accomplished, primarily, by recalling all miscellaneous permits in circulation and replacing with a standard form; all pertinent data being retained in a central control file.
3. It is impossible to list all allocation agents whose issues were validated. Such a list would include the majority of the service and movement branches of both armies, most of the operating agencies of AMGOT and AC and a large number of officers in the field.
4. This state of chaos resulted from the ridiculously small number of tires made available for release through direct AC channels. Agencies and officers with jobs to do were forced to make their own procurement arrangements with adjacent military units and army depots or through special authorizations of higher headquarters.
5. The replacement of miscellaneous forms issued to cover allocations as per paras 3 and 4 is not and never will be completed. Many Army agencies which were forced to issue thousands of tires to civilian firms working under military contracts never cleared through this headquarters

and many of these tires are still in circulation.

6. Naturally, the TN S/C screened all applications for permits and retained the authority for the original issue to validate release of standard form.

7. Only possible solution is the delegation to the Italian Government of authority to control all tires in civilian use and plan for such action has been presented to AFHQ for approval.

8. Para 1 of note 4 does not pertain. No organization allotted TN S/C the tires for which permits are issued and only God knows how many are still outstanding.

Il verificarsi di una tale evenienza, dato il nervosismo che si può notare nelle popolazioni dell'Isola per la deficienza dei pubblici servizi, potrebbe avere funeste conseguenze di portata non misurabile.-

Palermo 18 Oct. 1945

The transportation crises for the movement of goods and passengers caused by the lack of tires increases the many deficiencies in the Sicilian public service.

Numerous Communes are completely without any communications and therefore can't procure food or send the sick to the cities; all this apart from the other necessary communications of the Commune Authorities and the mail service which are not adequate to the needs.

The National Transportation Institute which has up to now done every thing possible to guarantee the indispensable service has informed us that it is about to stop its trips only for lack of tires.

If something of this kind should happen, it is difficult to measure the consequences which would be brought about by the already restless people of the Island.

Since the Allied Authorities have in other Region of Italy graciously granted tires "no longer in efficiency for military use " to the Italian Government, we beg you to examine the possibility of a similar allocation to this "Alto Commissariato" which would distribute them to that service indispensable for the life of the people of the Island.

The amount strictly necessary is of about 3000 tires of which we will send the sizes on your request.

4. The detention is understandable since transfer receipts did not accompany the vehicle but restitution should be made unless there were extenuating circumstances not mentioned in the complaint.

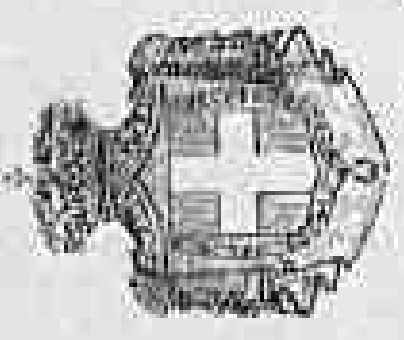

Noi sottoscritti Perelli Settimio e Caramanico Corrado autisti della macchina FIAT 634 n. 402 del Truck Pool n. 3 Chieti, dichiariamo quanto segue.

Nel viaggio di ritorno Rosignano - Chieti, con il carico di dodici solvay intenti a riparare una gomma posteriore destra, sopraggiungeva una jeep della M.P. americana del 139° Camp Thmpco con a bordo due M.P.'s uno dei quali richiedeva all'autista Perelli, intento alla suddetta riparazione, i documenti relativi al viaggio e, dopo averli esaminati, chiedeva ancora l'autorizzazione per l'uso di gomme Alleate. Essendo sprovvisti di essa, faceva salire a bordo della jeep l'autista Perelli, accompagnandolo al Comando di Polizia Alleata. Per mezzo dell'interprete chiedevano spiegazioni ancora in merito all'uso delle gomme, e l'autista faceva capire loro che si trattava di macchina ceduta dal Governo Alleato a quello Italiano.

We, Perelli Settimio and Caramanico Corrado drivers of the truck Fiat 634, No. 402, of the truck Pool No. 3, Chieti, certify the following :-

On the return trip Rosignano - Chieti, with a load of Solvay Soda, while repairing a flat tire, a jeep of the American M.P.s of the No. 139 Camp Thmpco stopped by us and one of the M.P.s asked the driver Perelli, for the documents regarding the trip. After having examined them he asked also for the papers authorizing the use of Allied tires. Not having them, he took the Perelli to the M.P. Station. With the aid on an interpreter Perelli was asked information regarding these use of Allied tires, and explained that the truck was done of those given by the Allies to the Italian Government.

In the meantime, while the driver Caramanico had gone to a vulcanizing shop to repair the tube, he was overtaken by the a/m jeep which loaded the driver and seized the tube.

After the interpreter at the M.P. Station had explained to the Commander the right to the tube this latter gave orders that the flat tube be returned in exchange of the spare tube (of a smaller size than those in the back wheels).

The exchange was asked by us after the Commander had denied the return of the tube. The driver Perelli was then asked to sign a receipt for the flat tube.

The number of the tube left to the M.P.s is the following :-

17480 E2 - Section 10,000 - 9,75 - 24 - 42x9.

For the a/m incident we were obliged to remain in Civitavecchia from 800 to 1400 hours of the 25/9.

The witness is Mr. Tucci Manin of Chieti.

1. Reference letter of Economic Section (5.10/23) of 14 September 1945 requesting release of stocks of tires and tubes under your control to the Ministry of Industry and Commerce.

2. By agreement the Minister of Industry and Commerce - Prof. Branchi - and the Director of this office of 21 September 1945, the Comitato Industriale per la Gomma will act as agent of the Italian Government in North Italy for the production and distribution of tires.

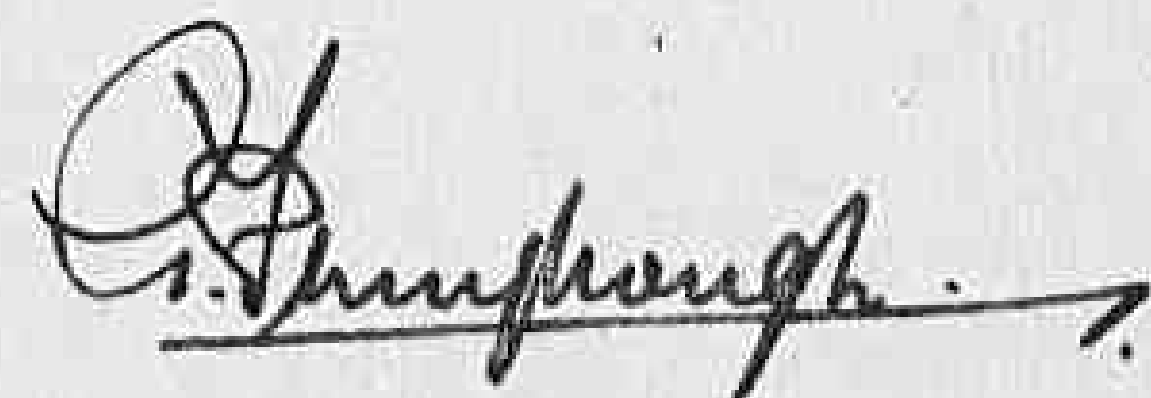

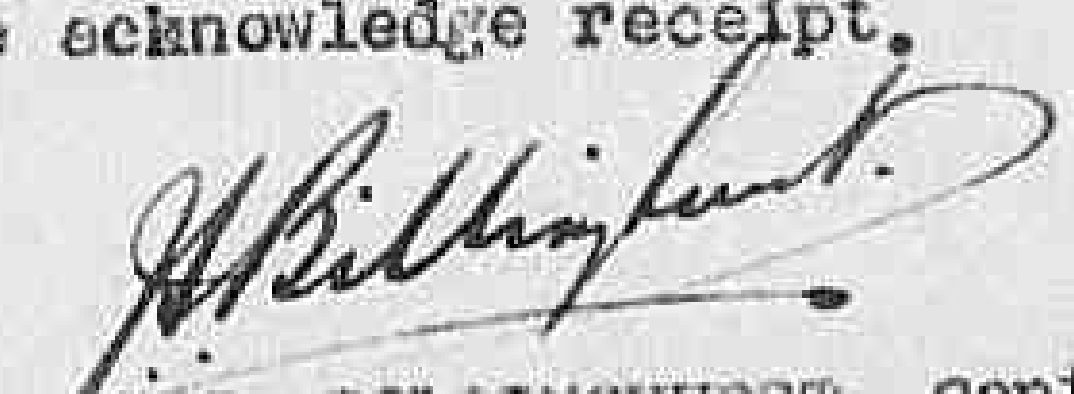

Reference your 540/40/Tn1 dated 9 Apr. '45 with letter AC/303/4/Tn5 dated 6 Apr. '45 attached.

1. It is noted that Transportation Subcommittee does not consider that the present status of control of tire and tubes is satisfactory and there is insufficient opportunity in AMG territory to indicate priorities either as regards sizes, areas or vehicles.

The only allocation made by Commerce Subcommittee has been the lot of some 2,650 tires which were handed over by Transportation when, at the request of the latter, Commerce undertook the distribution. The allocation was approved by the Priorities Board after the Director of the Transportation Subcommittee had signified his concurrence.

Regional Transportation officers are responsible for the distribution allocated to their Region.

The 750 x 20 tires issued to HQ Commandant were reallocated to Region VIII and Region IX for distribution by their Regional Transportation officers.

2. It is noted that a specific procedure should be evolved whereby issues can be made in Italian Government territory.

The correct channel is the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labour to whom an allocation will be made after decision by the Priorities Board on Monday, 16 April.

It is felt that it is an Italian Government responsibility to allocate any tires made available for use in their own territory, and it will be recommended that they set up a Board for equitable distribution amongst all their various claimants.

1332

3. It is admitted that the tire situation is critical but the amount of tires available today is the result of the efforts made by the responsible Subcommittee several months ago as it is well known that there is a time lag of some six months between requisition and procurement.

- 2 -

The responsibility of this Subcommittee dates back barely three months, and your attention is called to our letter dated 4 Apr. '45 AC/5095/Commerce addressed to Transportation Subcommittee (Attn. Lt. Col. C. E. Harris) wherein the distribution of the 2,650 tires is referred to, the steps taken to expedite further deliveries, the quantities that are now available, the balance still to come forward, the anticipated production when Pirelli Factory goes into production.

4. Reference is made to your letter of 7 Apr. '45 regarding tires for Northern Italy.

Requirements are given as 24,500, broken down as follows:

600 x 16	=	2,450
750 x 20	=	6,125
900 x 20	=	9,800
42 x 9	=	<u>6,125</u>

The balance yet to come forward on AFHQ IAC Airgram 58 dated 30 Aug. '44, which indicated overall requirements for all Italy, is only 9,386. This Subcommittee will take the necessary steps to request that the difference of 15,114 (24,500 - 9,386 = 15,114) be requisitioned, but it will be appreciated that it will probably be some months before they can be made available, if approved.

5. Regarding para. 2, sub-para. (a) and (b) of your 303/2/Tn5, it is suggested that application be made for membership of the Priorities Board. A statement of availability is distributed to all members of the Board before allocation is made.

Economic Section issued instructions on 10 Mar. '45 (AC/5095/Commerce) on Issue of Tires and Tubes to Regions for Civilian Purposes. If Transportation Subcommittee wishes to have a weekly statement of issue vouchers for tires distributed by its Regional Transportation officers or by I.S.R., it should give necessary instructions to its own officers. No useful purpose could be served by filing with Transportation Subcommittee issue vouchers of tires distributed by C.I.P., P.W. & U. or HQ Commandant.

6. The information requested in para. 2 sub-para. (c) has been furnished with letter 5095 dated 4 April.

7. For the purposes of bookkeeping, it is preferable that the

These vehicles were in charge of an Italian officer, and it is not known whether they belong to you or to the Italian State Railways.

However, some of these vehicles were jacked-up and off the road for lack of tyres (1050 x 20 or 1050 x 16) and I am wondering if the provision of these tyres is an A.C. responsibility or not. If it is, then it is possible that Southern Region have included these vehicles in their demand for 143 tyres in addition to the 91 sent to them last week.

Perhaps you would be kind enough to check up on this.
