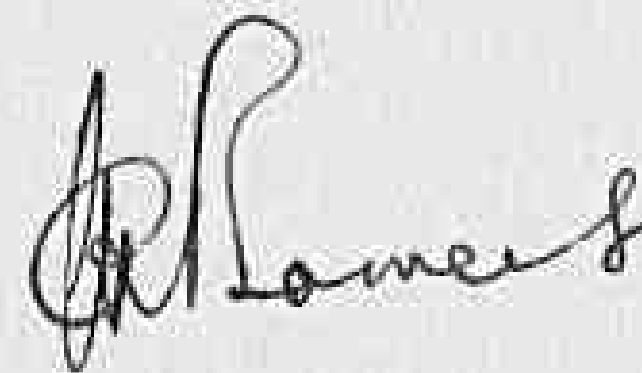

It has been confirmed that tyres for the Genio Civile vehicles and vehicles of approved contractors can be obtained under this authority, when the AC Transportation Sub-Commission arrange for the sale of such tyres through the AC Commerce Sub Division who are responsible for the financial accounting.

3. The attached letter ref 188/AG7 dated 1 Mar 45 with Lists Nos. 1 and 3 from the Genio Civile forwarded herewith for your attention includes the following demand for tyres and inner tubes :-

1. Some time ago it was proposed that certain parts of WD vehicles normally rendered to scrap could, if made available in existing form, be useful in keeping civil transport on the road (e.g. broken spark plugs, scrap storage batteries and worn pistons, which could be re-fabricated by local industries).

2. Q(AE) at this HQ published a Salvage Instruction from which the following is an extract:

"(b) M.T. Spares from W.D. Vehicles, & Tyres, will not be offered to M.M.I.A. or A.C. in bulk. Re-issues may be made against specific demands received from:

(i) M.M.I.A. :- demand to be certified by M.M.I.A. Liaison Officer.

(ii) A.C. :- demand to be signed by British Officer of A.C. Transportation Sub-Committee.

(c) The instructions detailed in (b) (i) and (ii) above do not apply to material held in Vehicle Disposal Depots, with the exception of the following parts:-

Chassis frames.

Bodies

Sheet steel parts classified as light iron."

3. All salvage from U.S. sources, prior to sale on open market, is offered to Allied Commission under the provisions of MTOUSA Circular 14, dated 25 January 1945.

4. Will you please inform this HQ whether you are satisfied that (a) full use is being made of salvage from both these sources to get civilian trucks back on to the road with the help of salvaged military parts, (b) there is close co-ordination between the Sub-Commissions concerned with salvage, transportation and industry, on this subject.
