1. Reference your letter, AC/331/50/TN.5 of 30th July, 1945.

2. I have investigated all the facts, and find that they are indeed exactly as stated by you.

3. It is greatly regretted that such an error should have taken place in my Region.

4. You will know, better than most, that I have never had nearly enough transportation officers to carry on the work in this Region, geographically the largest that has ever been under A.M.G. rule in Italy. If Provincial Supply Officers had not been called on at times to help bear the load, transportation would never have got going.

5. Capt. MacLachlan is one of the very best of a good team of Provincial Supply Officers. In this case, at a time of great pressure, and acting in perfectly good faith, he took a step which was contrary to regulations. He has expressed his regret.
