Miss Laura Chiarella, Chilean citizen, resident in Rome, Via Arno 88, is the owner of a Camion Ford V.'. plate No. Rome 54928. The camion was sold to her fitted with Allied Military tyres, a fact which she did not note at the time of the purchase, but as soon as she become aware of this incorrect procedure on the part of the vendor she informed the Allied Authorities.

Milist the above irregularity is being examined by the Allied Authorities, and taking into consideration that the camion renders services to the Chilean Embassy, Miss Chiarella respectfully asks the Allied Commission to kindly give her authorization, for an indefinite period, for the camion in question to be driven, even though it is fitted with Allied Military tyres.

The Chilean Embassy thanks the Allied Commission in advance for anything it may be able to do in the matter, and takes the opportunity to renew its expressions of the highest consideration.
