SUBJECT: Transfer of Vehicles to Allied Commission

TO : Commanding General
Peninsular Base Section
APO 782

1. Action will be taken to transfer to the Allied Commission 200 each trucks, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ton, 2x4 Chevrolets, received from MIDEAST Turkish stockpile during the period May to October 1944.
2. These trucks will be billed in dollars at estimated cost, plus the estimated cost of the spare parts furnished.
3. The subject trucks were transferred to you by British Ordnance, who had received and issued them to the Allied Commission. Reference is made to letter, this headquarters, file AG 451/162 D-0, dated 15 April 1945, subject: "Trucks $1\frac{1}{2}$ ton on loan to Allied Commission". If the four (4) vehicles mentioned in paragraph 3 of basic letter have not been released from British stocks and transferred by you to Allied Commission, this headquarters must be informed.
4. The foregoing action is directed in compliance with CC/3 cable CAL 1362 (WK-84932), dated 19 May 1945. This transaction will be handled in the normal manner by the use of a shipping ticket.
