1. Since the Agriculture Office at Bari is closed, your letter comes to the attention of this Office.

2. It happens that I signed as Requisitioning Officer for these cars and a full report was transmitted to the Agricultural Sub-Commission in Rome for the attention of Lt. Col. Andrews, who provided requisition forms and gave instructions on the requisitioning and disposition of these cars.

3. These cars were requisitioned for the use of Agricultural Officials but were to be carried on the Regional strength and assigned by the Provincial Commissioners to Agricultural Officials, subject to recall.

4. The car at Brindisi, License N° BR 2322, was the property of the Inspector of Agriculture and was requisitioned from him for the use of that Office so that we could provide War Department tyres to enable him to operate the car.

5. The two cars at Lecce were turned over to the Provincial Commissioner for assignment to Italian Agricultural Officials. There are no records in this Office as to what agencies used these cars. At one time they were held in the Provincial pool available for loan to various Agricultural Officials in consideration of their separate needs and the importance of work to be done.

6. The list of cars with the note at the bottom signed by me was given to the Regional Transportation Officer, so that War Department parts could be provided and that they could be entered on Regional records.

C.G. P.B.S. D.D.S.T.

- 1) Under A.P.H.Q. Adm. Memo No 92 dated 15th December 1943, the C-in-C, A.C.M.F. is authorized to divert military resources including transport to facilitate the feeding of the civil population.
- 2) C-in-C, A.C.M.F., has decided to meet the requirement of A.C.C. in regard to transport as follows:-

(a) One G.T. Coy strength 120 load carrying vehicles to be detailed by D.D.S.T., A.P.H.Q., Adv.Ech. for attachment to ACC.

(b) A transport unit self contained in every respect, strength not less than 80 load carrying vehicles to be detailed by C.G. P.B.S., for temporary attachment to A.C.C.

(c) The units mentioned in (a) and (b) above should preferably be manned by Italian Military personnel, but this is left to the discretion of the authorities responsible for providing them. They will be made available by 20 Feb. 1944. Deputy President A.C.C. will inform C.G. P.B.S., and this H.Q. where they should report.

(d) Further assistance will be given by the provision of vehicles with which ACC will form civilian transport units. These vehicles will be found as follows:

By C.G. P.B.S., 300 - 24 trucks are being shipped, for the purpose from Oran and are due Naples by 15 Feb. Of these 80 may be retained by P.B.S., as off set to those supplied with the unit mentioned in para (b) above.

D.D.S.T. Flamo, following consignments of ten lorries 4x2 are being made available by A.P.H.Q.,

(e) Arrangements for taking over vehicles mentioned in (d) above will be made direct between A.C.C. and authorities responsible for supplying them who will issue all necessary instructions concerning documentation of vehicles handed over.

3) (a) A.C.C. will arrange with C.G. P.B.S., and D.D.M.B. Flambo for periodical inspections and maintenance of vehicles in the units mentioned in paras 2 (a) and (b) above. It is essential that the work of these units should be so arranged as to permit regular maintenance.

(b) A.C.C. will be responsible for maintenance of the vehicles mentioned in paras 2 (d). A.C.C., will indent (requisition) on

A.D.O.S., Area and C.G. P.B.S., for spare parts and accessories required to maintain the British and American vehicles, handed over in accordance with the normal British and American indent (requisition) procedure.
