SUBJECT : Second batch of vehicles, ex-"HOUSTON and CURRY".

TO : Captain PETERSON (Trans-sub-Comm.) - Rome.

Attached is a list of rail car tally out sheets on vehicles sent to A.T.A.G. Rome during the period, approximately, 12 March-20 March. There is shown a total of 186 Chassis, 190 Cabs, and 177 Bodies shipped. There should have been 193 Chassis, 193 Cabs, and 179 Bodies. This difference, of 5 short Chassis, 3 short Cabs and 2 short Bodies, appears. However, I am of the opinion that mistakes were made by Depot 11157 which handled this shipment. You should have received the manifested number.

A close check should be made at your end as to actual numbers received. This office should be notified. Finally, a copy of the tally out sheets should be signed and returned to Commercial Traffic Section of 10th Port of Embarkation, Italy.

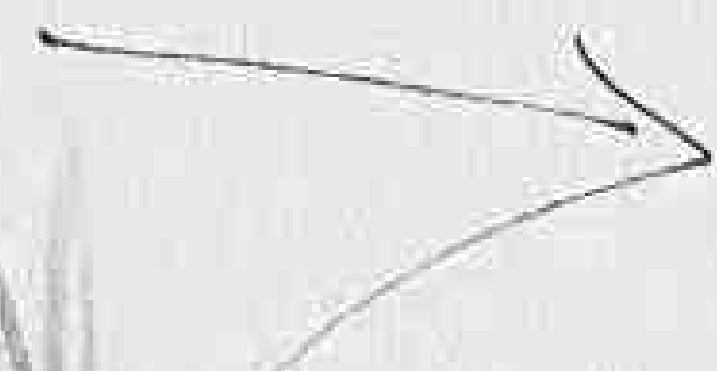

1. Report follows in re request for statement of trucks received to date via BA 681, 669 and 654.

A. BA 654, Andrew Moore discharged at Naples. Manifest indicated 62 cases, vehicles. So far only 54 cases have been located totalling 50 chassis and 58 cabs.

B. BA 681 and 669, Francis Marion and George H. Thomas, respectively, discharged at Livorno. Reports from there show 10 trucks in process or assembly.

C. Advance information sent concerning these shipments indicated 62 trucks shipped via 654, 4 via 681 and 6 via 669.

D. This total, 72, is in variance with the 115 indicated in Col. Butterworth's letter.

E. No final statement of trucks available can be reached until all cases have been located and checked.

F. It is not probable that the Feb. 20, 1945 release date requested by Col. Butterworth can be met either as to number (he asks for 120) or time. The assembling of these at Naples has not yet been begun and no more are expected to arrive in time to be assembled by that date.
